# CURRICULUM

The medium of instructions at all levels is English; however the students are also encouraged to develop proficiency in atleast three other languages.

For the holistic development of the students, skill based activities are part of school curriculum. It is mandatory for each student to participate in these activities in an academic year.

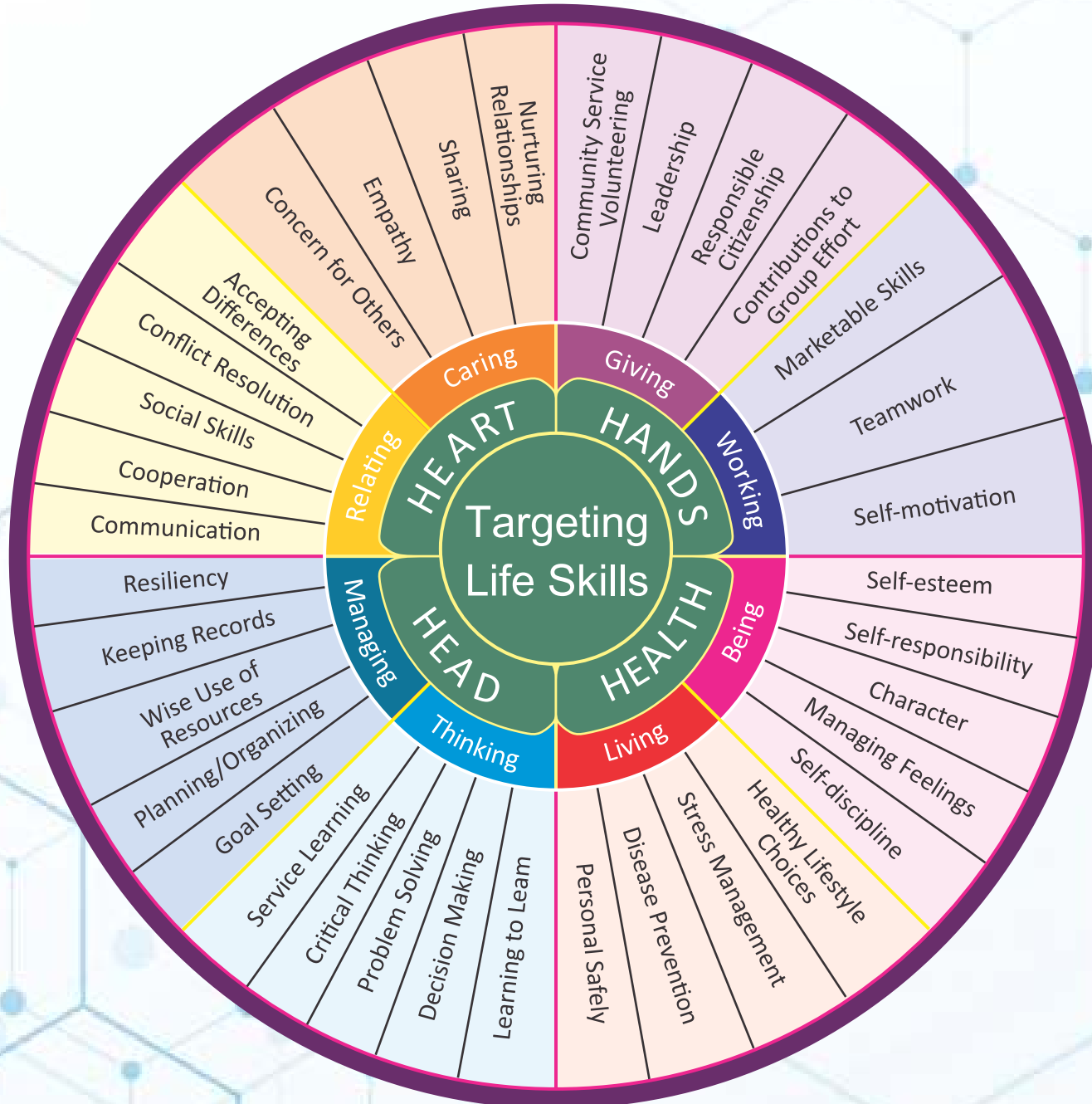
## SKILL HUB INITIATIVE

# The SKILL hub



For upskilling the youth, the Govt. has introduced the 'Skill Hub Initiative' under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana 3.0 (PMKVY 3.0). In the initial phase, Govt has identified 5,000 skill hub centres across the country and Bhavan Vidyalaya Panchkula has been designated as one of the Skill Hub Centre in Panchkula region. The school provides skill development and vocational training in two courses - Telecom and Tourism & Hospitality. The courses are open to the age group 15-29 years covering the in-school students of Classes IX-XII, drop-outs and out-of-education candidates.

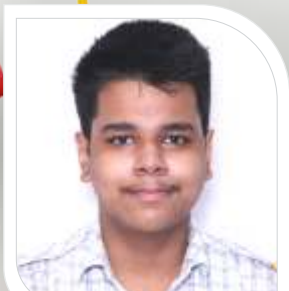




# Panchkula Bhavanites soar high in Class X and Class XII Board Results
