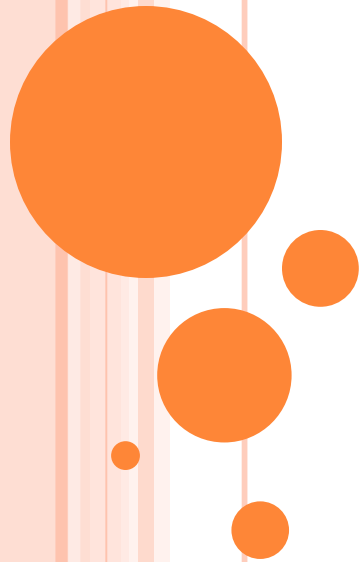




NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)

NCC FLAG



- NCC Flag Contains **NCC Crest** in gold in the middle, with the letters "**NCC**" encircled by a wreath of seventeen lotus with a background in **Red, Blue and Light blue**.
- **Red** depicts the **Army**, **Deep Blue** depicts the **Navy** and **Light Blue** depicts the **Air Force**.
- The seventeen lotuses represent the **17 State Directorates**.

TRAINING



- Drill, Shooting, Physical Fitness, Map Reading, First aid and Camp Training covering basic of Military Training in Army, Navy and Air Force.
- **Total Training period for Junior Division(JD) & Junior Wing (JW) is of 2 years.**
- Every cadet of the **Junior Division(JD) & Junior Wing (JW)** has to undergo **service training in the Second Year.**

TYPES OF CERTIFICATES

- NCC gives three types of certificates to its Cadets based on their level of Training.

NCC “A” Certificate

- This certificate is given to the Cadet when they complete the first level of Training. Candidates who are either Junior Wing (JW) or Junior Division (JD) Cadets in the NCC can appear for the NCC “A” certification exam during the 8th or 9th standard.





NCC “B” Certificate

- This certificate is given to the Cadet when they complete the Second level of Training. Candidates who are either Senior Wing (JW) or Senior Division (JD) Cadets in the NCC can appear for the NCC “B” certification exam.

NCC “C” Certificate

- This certificate is given to the Cadet when they complete the Third level of Training with minimum 2 National Training. Candidates who are either Senior Wing (JW) or Senior Division (JD) Cadets in the NCC can appear for the NCC “C” certification exam
