HAD A REAL DASH.

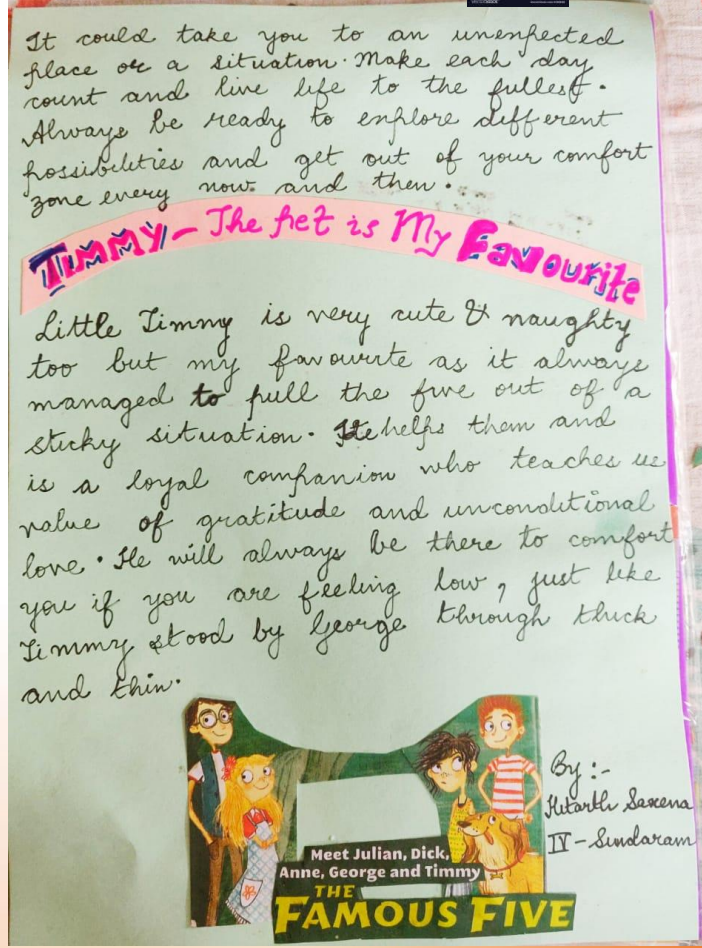
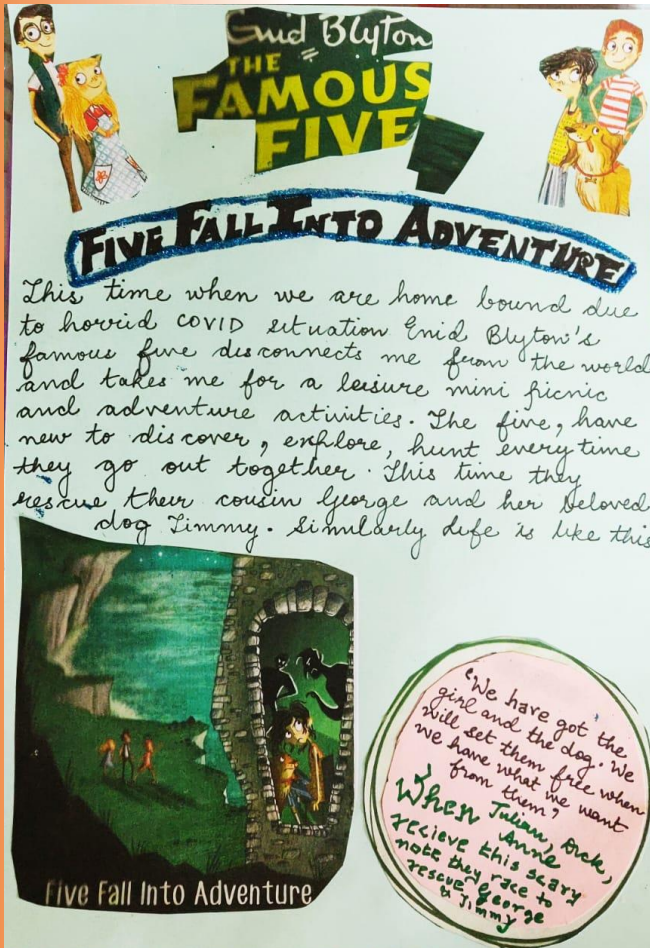

Article on World Earth Day





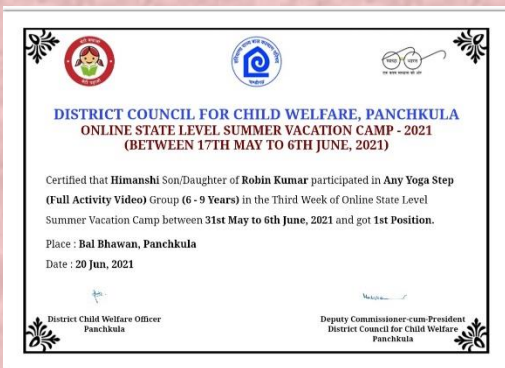
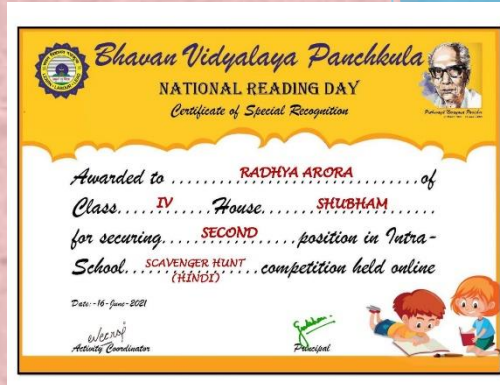
