Ambedkar Jayanti

Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar' was born on 14 April 1891 in Mhow town of Madhya Pradesh, India. He was the son of Ramji Maloji Sakpal and Bhimabai. His father served in the Indian Army at the Mhow cantonment. He became one of the first Dalit (untouchables) to obtain a college education in India, eventually earning a law degree and doctorates for his study and research in law, economics and political science.

Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar is popularly known as 'Babasaheb'. He was an Indian jurist, political leader, philosopher, anthropologist, historian, orator, economist, teacher, editor, prolific writer, revolutionary and a revivalist for Buddhism in India. He became the 1st Law Minister of India. He became the Chairman of the Constitution Drafting Committee. For his contributions, he was awarded with 'Bharat Ratna'.

He died on 6 December 1956 at his home in Delhi.

Dr Ambedkar wrote free India's constitution. Ambedkar Jayanti is celebrated every year on 14th April as a mark of respect across the country



RAMNAVAMI



Ram Navami marks the birthday of lord Ram, the eldest son of King Dashratha and queen Kaushalya of Ayodhya who was born in tretha yug. He is considered as seventh avatar of Vishnu ji . Ram Navami is celebrated on ninth Chaitra navratra across India as a very important Hindu festival.



BAISAKHI



Baisakhi is the celebration of the start of Sikh New year and harvest season.Guru Gobind Singh chose the auspicious day of Baisakhi for the formation of Khalsa Panth in 1699. Baisakhi is a festival of all over India with different names and customs. Bhangra and Gidda performance by men and women are the eyes-catching events of Baisakhi.People also pay tribute to the martyrs of Jallianwala Bagh who sacrificed their lives for the country on this very day. The Golden Temple looks very beautiful at the festival, especially at night. Taking a dip in the sacred Amrit Sarovar at Golden Temple on Baisakhi is a tradition to cure people and wash their bad karmas.Baisakhi at the Golden Temple also becomes significant because it was the place where Guru Gobind Singh laid the foundation of the Khalsa Panth.Baisakhi has the tradition of dance, music and enjoyment and commemorates the virtue of our great gurus and saints.
