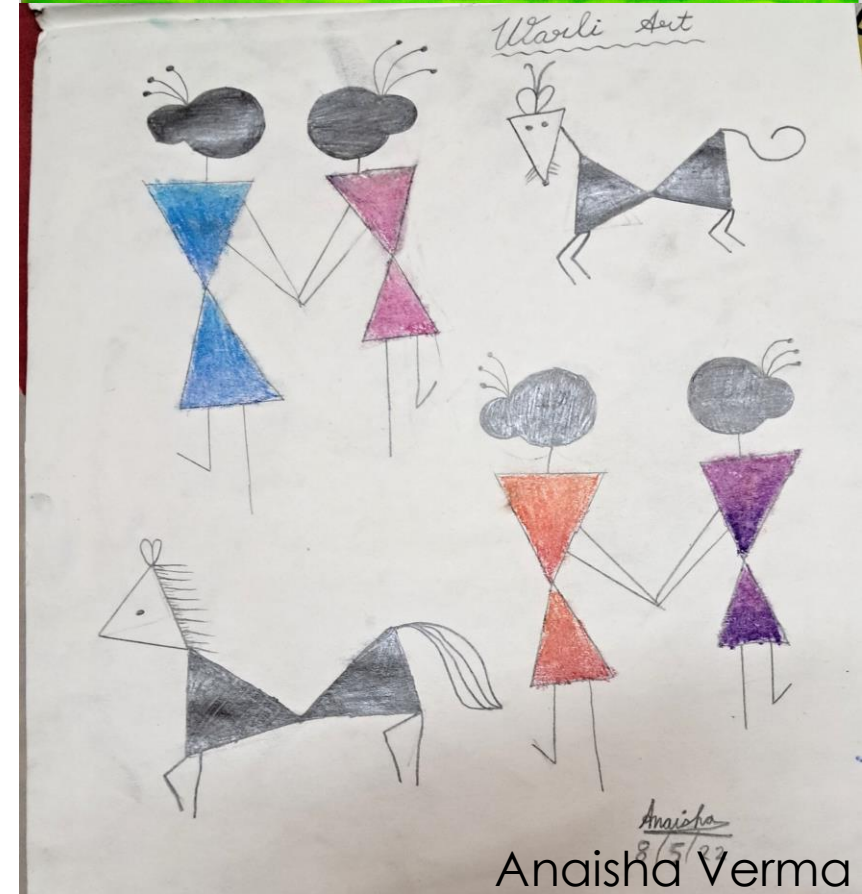


1. Recycling one aluminum can save enough energy to run a Television for three hours.

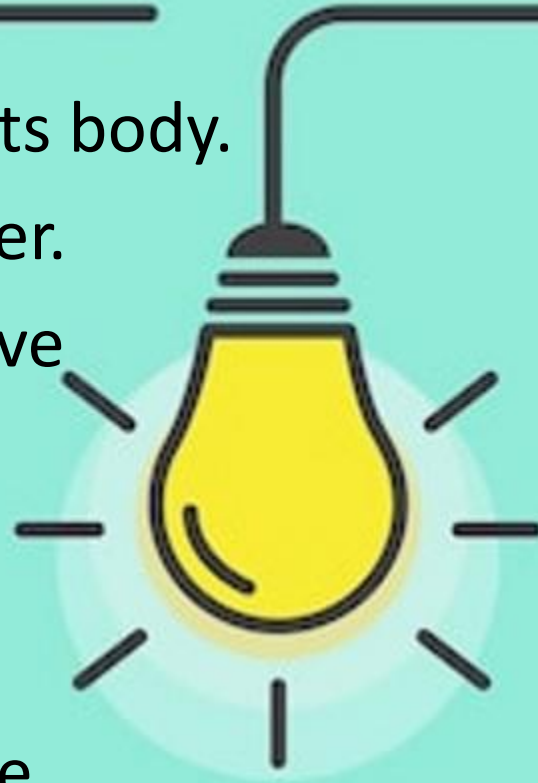

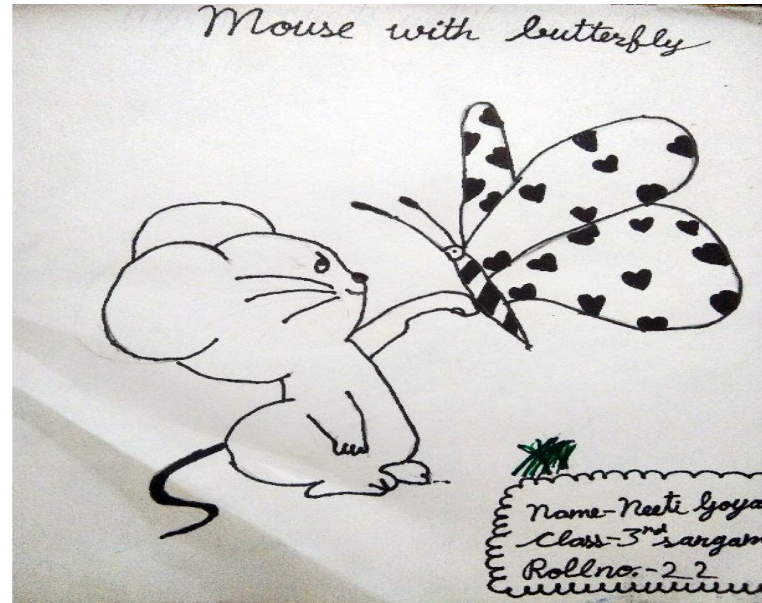

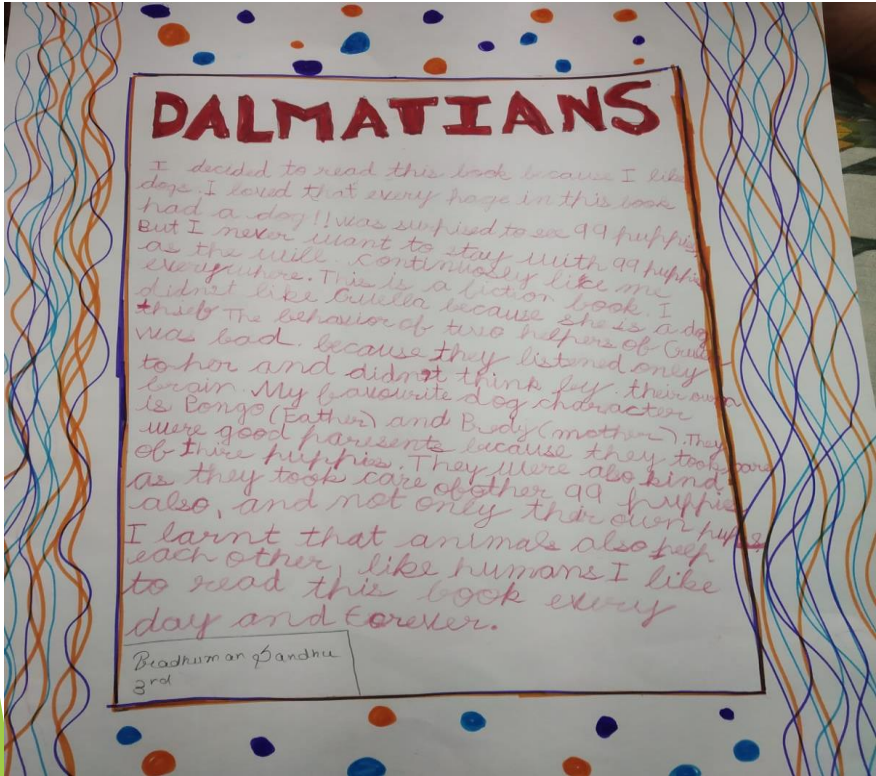
