They both holds a flag with their hands and sing the national anthem of India. They watch the special program about Independence Day on their televisions (T.V.).



PEEP INTO THE PAST

India is celebrating its 74th independence day on 15th august 2020; let's have an insight into how was India's first independence day..... 1. India had no national anthem when it became an independent country on 15th August, 1947. Jana Gana Mana written by Rabindranath Tagore was adopted as India's national anthem later in the 1950s. 2. The Governor General was the only and the most authoritative person in India at the time of independence. 3. Although India became independent on July 18, 1947, Lord Mountbatten declared 15th August as the date of Independence because this date observed the second anniversary of the surrendering of Japan to the Allied Forces during World War II. 4. The National Flag was first hoisted at the Parsee Bagan Square in Calcutta on August 7, 1906. The first variant of the national flag was designed by Pingali Venkayya in 1921. 5. India shares its Independence Day with five more countries on August 15, but with different years. The countries are Bahrain, North Korea, South Korea, Congo, and Liechtenstein. 6. Goa, a Portuguese colony, was made a part of India in 1961 after Indian troops annexed the state to India. 7. The Khadi Development and Village Industries Commission is the only licenced company engaged in the production and supply of Indian flag. The Karnataka Khadi Gramodyog Samyukta Sangha located in Dharwad is the only manufacturer of the flag made with cotton. 8. Mahatma Gandhi was absent from the celebrations of the country's first Independence Day. He was there to be a part of a hunger strike that was conducted to impede the communal killings that were triggered due to partition. 9. Cyril John Radcliffe was given the task of drawing the borders of the Independent India. Despite the fact that he had never come to India, he was given this task of division of the country. 10. Hindi was declared as the official language of India on 14th

10. Hindi was declared as the official language of India on 14th September, 1949. 11. Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, India's first Prime Minister, hoisted the national flag 17 times from the fortification of the Red Fort on the Independence Day. 12. Although the plan of Partition was declared on June 3, 1947, it was executed on August 14, 1947, the date on which Pakistan was formed. On August 15, 1947, the Independent Sovereign Republic of India came into being.

Where are the coins minted in India?


The India Government Mint operates four mints in India for the production of coins:


