



Where: Mumbai, Maharashtra


What's Special: The Dahi Handi where the clay pot is filled with curd is hung over with a thread. Young boys make a human pyramid and hit the pot with a stick.











#### **Black hole**



A black hole is a region of <u>spacetime</u> where <u>gravity</u> is so strong that nothing—no <u>particles</u> or even <u>electromagnetic radiation</u> such as <u>light</u>—can escape from it! The theory of <u>general relativity predicts</u> that a <u>sufficiently</u> compact <u>mass</u> can deform spacetime to form a black hole. The boundary of the region from which no escape is possible is called the <u>event horizon</u>. Although the event horizon has an enormous effect on the fate and circumstances of an object crossing it, according to general relativity it has no locally detectable features.



#### INDIA HISTORY(INDEPENDENCE DAY SPECIAL)



#### ADAM, SBRIDGE [RAMSETU]

Adam's Bridge, also known as Rama's Bridge or Rama Setu, is a chain of <u>limestone shoals</u>, between <u>Pamban Island</u>, also known as Rameswaram Island, off the south-eastern coast of <u>Tamil Nadu</u>, <u>India</u>, and <u>Mannar Island</u>, off the north-western coast of <u>Sri Lanka</u>. Geological evidence suggests that this bridge is a former land connection between India and Sri Lanka.



The bridge is 48 km (30 mi) long and separates the <u>Gulf of Mannar</u> (southwest) from the <u>Palk Strait</u> (northeast). Some of the regions are dry and the
sea in the area rarely exceeds 1 metre (3 ft) in depth, thus hindering
navigation. It was reportedly passable on foot until the 15th century, when
storms deepened the channel: temple records seem to say that Adam's
Bridge was completely above sea level until it broke in a <u>cyclone</u> in 1480




