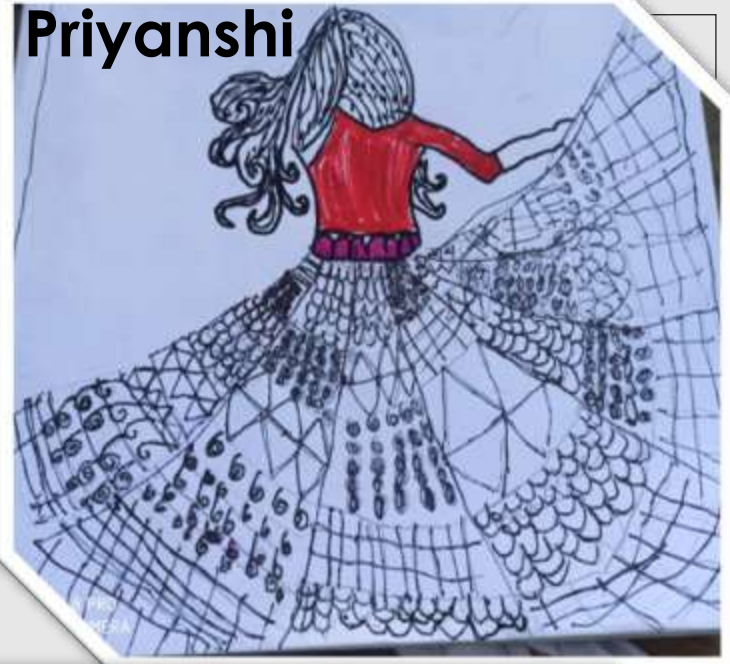


Rakshabandhan

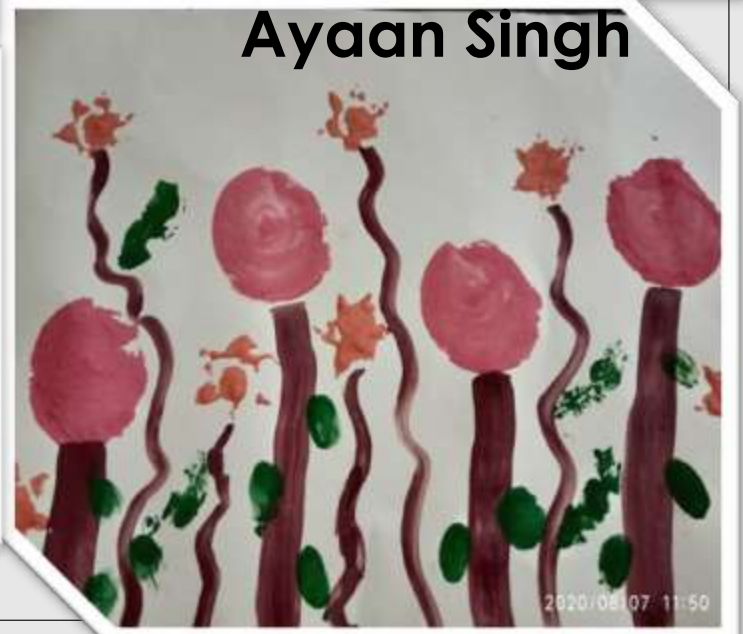

Do you know not all stones sink in water?

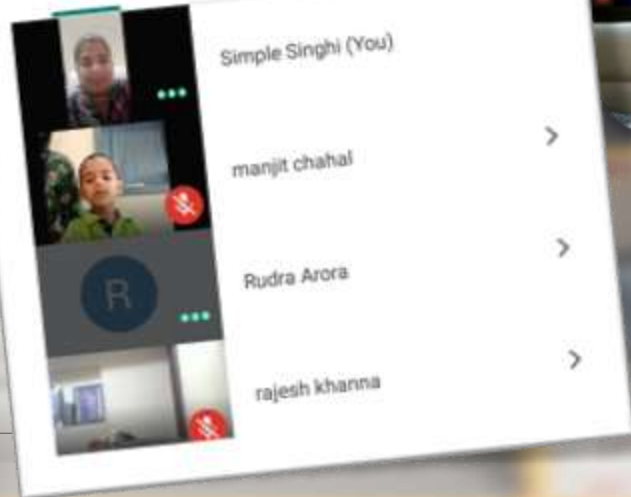
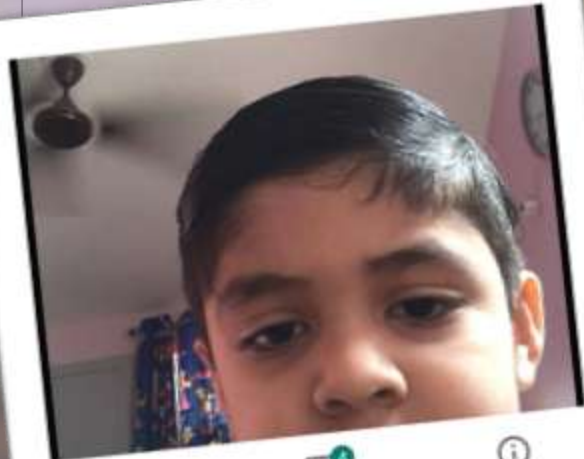
Pumice stone floats on water!

Pumice stone floats on water because it has an incredibly low density due to the air bubbles inside it. As it is blown out of a volcano, and dissolved gases exsolve and more air gets into it before it hardens into pumice. The less dense air offsets the more dense rock, causing it to float.
