The Indian Armed Forces

An Article on The Indian Armed Forces

The Indian Armed Forces are the military forces of the Republic of India. It consists of three professional uniformed services: the Indian Army, Indian Navy, and Indian Air Force. The Royal Indian Navy was first established by the British. In 1892, it became a maritime component as the Royal Indian Marine (RIM).In 1932, the Indian Air Force was established as an auxiliary air force; two years later, the RIM was upgraded to the status of a naval service as the Royal Indian Navy (RIN).In World War II, the Indian Army began the war in 1939 with just under 200,000 men. By the end of the war, it had become the largest volunteer army in history, rising to over 2.5 million men by August 1945.

Dominion of India (1947 to 1950):

The period immediately following Indian independence was a traumatic time for India and her armed services.

Along with the newly independent India, the Indian Armed Forces were forcibly divided between India and Pakistan, with ships, divisions and aircraft allocated to the respective Dominions.

Republic of India (1950 to present):

Upon India becoming a sovereign republic on 26 January 1950, some of the last vestiges of British rule – such as rank badges, imperial crowns, British ensigns and "Royal" monikers – were dropped and replaced with the Indian tricolour and the Lion Capital of Asoka. In 1961 tensions rose between India and Portugal over the Portuguese-occupied territory of Goa, which India claimed for itself. Goa was annexed by India with the Indian Armed Forces.Indiafought four major wars withPakistan in 1947, 1965, 1971 and 1999, and with China in 1962. Indian victory over Pakistan in the 1971 war, helped create the free country of Bangladesh.

Overview:

The headquarters of the Indian Armed Forces is in New Delhi, the capital city of India. The President of India serves as the formal Supreme Commander of the Indian Armed Forces, while actual control lies with the executive headed by the Prime Minister of India. The Ministry of Defence (MoD) is the ministry charged with the responsibilities of countering insurgency and ensuring external security of India. Present Ministry of Defence is Rajnath Singh.Retired Army chief, General Bipin Rawat, was appointed no December 30 the first tri-service Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) post, with effect from December 31, 2019.General Manoj Mukund Naravane is the Chief of the Army Staff (COAS), Admiral Karambir Singh is the Chief of the Naval Staff (CNS) and Air Chief Marshal Rakesh Kumar Singh Bhadauria is the Chief of the Air Staff (CAS).

The Armed Forces have four main tasks;

- •To assert the territorial integrity of India.
- •To defend the country if attacked by a foreign nation.
- To support the civil community in case of disasters (e.g. flooding).
- To participate in <u>United Nations</u> peacekeeping operations in consonance with India's commitment to the United Nations Charter.

This festival is mainly related to harvesting of rabi (sugarcane)crops. People wear new clothes on this festival and sing, dance around a large bonfire to celebrated.

SUBASH CHANDRA BOSE

Subhas Chandra Bose' was born on 23rd January 1897 in Cuttack, Orissa, India. His mother's name was Prabhavati Devi. His father Janakinath Bose was an advocate.

In the course of struggle for freedom Subhas Chandra Bose formed 'Azad Hind Fauz' and led the 'Indian National Army'. He advocated a revolutionary and violent way to protest as opposed to non-violent approach by Mahatma Gandhi. He separated from Indian National Congress (INC) and founded his own party 'All India Forward Block'.

He led an Indian national force from abroad against the Western powers during <u>World War II</u>. He was a contemporary of <u>Mohandas K. Gandhi</u>, at times an ally and at other times an adversary. Bose was known in particular for his militant approach to independence and for his push for <u>socialist</u> policies.

Subhas Chandra Bose was one of the most prominent leaders of the Indian Independence Movement. He spread the feeling of national integration, sacrifice and communal harmony among the masses.

Subhash Chandra Bose Jayanti is celebrated on 23rd January every year across the country. His Jayanti is celebrated in a grand way among the party members of Forward Block. All the district administration and the local civic body also observe Subhash Chandra Bose Jayanti. Many N.G.O.s organizes Blood Donation Camps. On this day the schools organize various activities as exhibition, quiz and cultural programs. His birthday is also celebrated as Desh Prem Diwas.






- Pigs are reared for meat. Different cuts of meat are named differently – like rump steak, sirloin, sausage, ham, bacon, salami.






Article on Anti-Corruption Day
