Christmas is also known as Christmastide that end on 6 January which means on the 12 day of Christmas during which people remember epiphany.

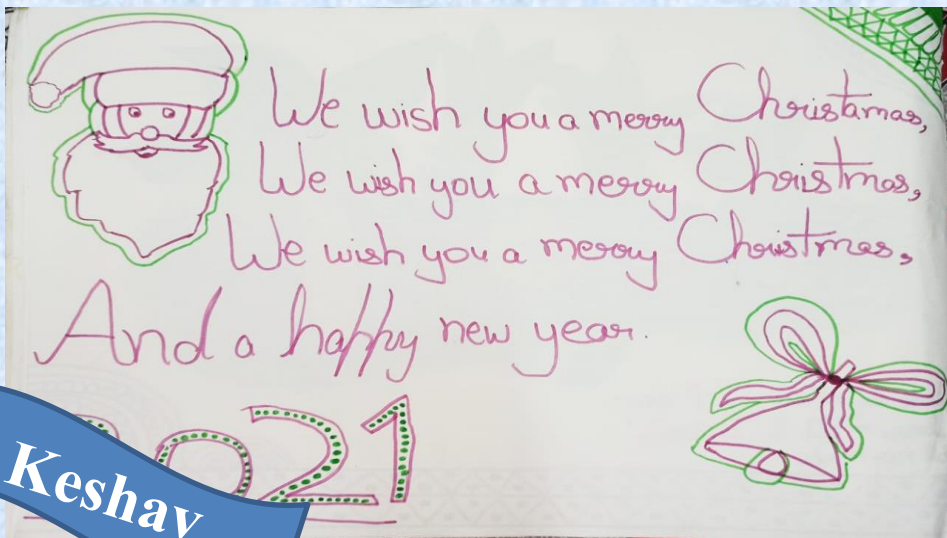

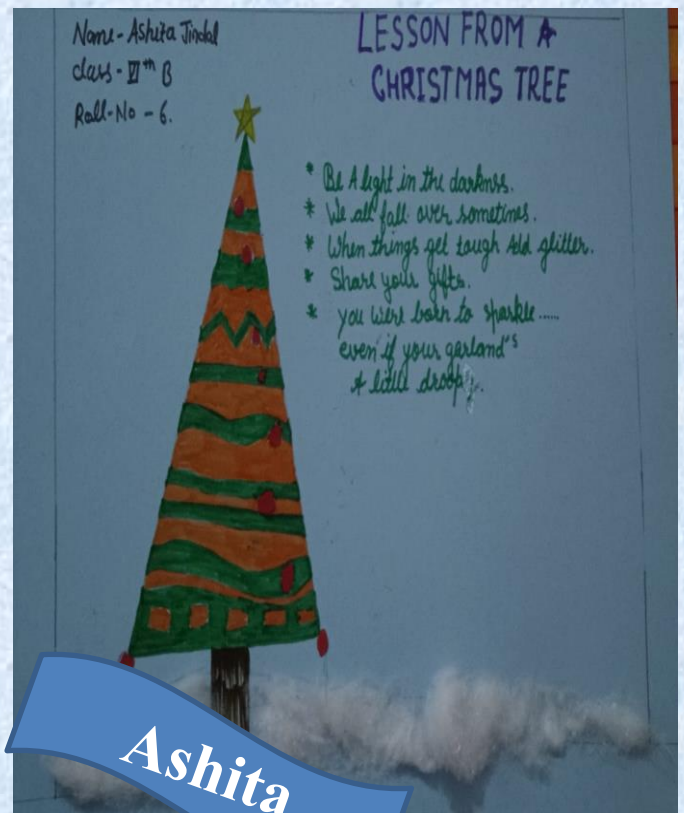

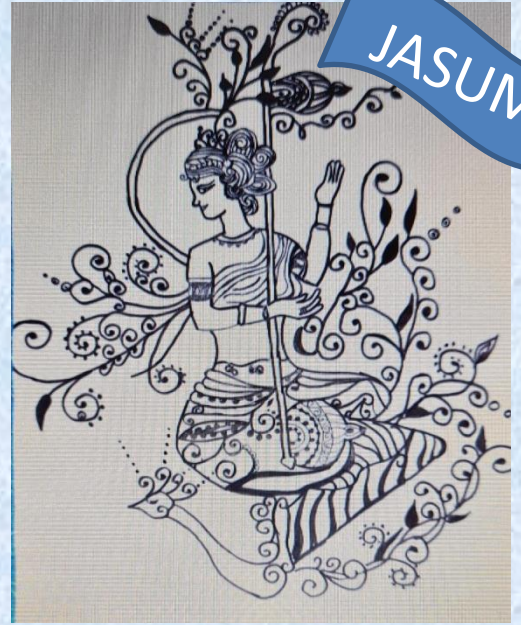
He was an Indian Nationalist whose patriotism towards India has left a mark in the hearts of many Indians.

# ***BASANT PANCHAMI***

The festival of Basant Panchami is dedicated to Saraswati, the Goddess of wisdom. According to the Hindu mythology, the goddess symbolizes constant flow of knowledge and wisdom. Vasant Panchami is also believed as the birthday of Goddess Saraswati. The spring festival of Basant Panchami is especially celebrated in the institutions of learning. As Saraswati is the goddess of learning, Students observe the blessings from Maa Saraswati. Spring is the season when crops are fully bloomed, so people also celebrate this occasion by flying kites. Vasant Panchami marks the beginning of the spring season. The festival of spring is celebrated with full vivacity and joy amongst the Hindu people. In Hindi language, the word " basant / vasant" means "spring" and "Panchami" means the fifth day. In short, Basant Panchami is celebrated as the fifth day of Spring Season. Vasant Panchami falls on the fifth day of the Indian month, Maagh (January-February). This festival is also known as Saraswati Puja. Yellow color is given special attention and dominates everywhere on this particular day. Yellow color is associated with Goddess Saraswati as well as the mustard crop. People wear yellow clothes, make yellow color sweets on the day of Saraswati Puja. The Goddess of art, learning, knowledge and wisdom, Maa Saraswati is worshipped with full dedication. On this day, People also feed Brahmins with the feeling that their ancestors are accepting the food. Kite-flying has become the part of this festival and people really enjoy this event. Basant Panchami is a festival full of religious, seasonal and social significance. It is celebrated by Hindus all over the world with enthusiasm and new sense of optimism.

## WORLD AIDS DAY



World Aids Day, designated on 1 December every year since 1988, is an international day dedicated to raising awareness of the Aids pandemic caused by the spread of HIV infection and mourning those who have died of the ~~the~~ disease. The acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) is a life threatening condition caused by the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). The HIV virus attacks the immune system of the patient and reduces its resistance to other diseases. Government and health officials, non-governmental organizations, and individuals around the world observe the day, often with education on AIDS prevention and control. World AIDS Day is one of the eleven official global public health campaigns marked by the World Health Organization (WHO), along with World Health Day, World Blood Donor Day, World Immunization Week, World Tuberculosis Day, World No Tobacco Day, World Malaria Day, World Hepatitis Day, World Antimicrobial Awareness Week, World Patient Safety Day and World Chagas Disease Day. As of 2017, AIDS has killed between 28.9 million and 41.5 million people worldwide, and an estimated 36.7 million people are living with HIV making it one of the most important global public health issues in recorded history.

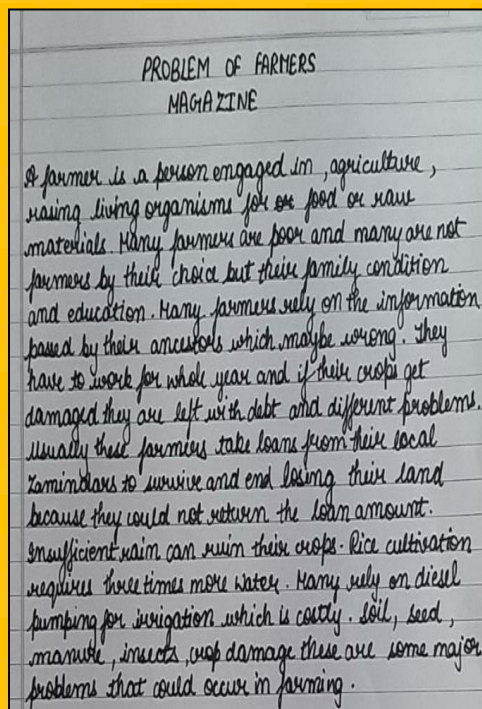


# KISAN DIWAS

## 'Electronic Safe Box'

**Introduction** - My name is Advit Kathuria and I am a student of Class 6th Sangam in Bhavan Vidyalaya Panchkula. As we all know thefts are happening in India. Therefore we all need to be cautious to keep our valuables in a safe. I have made a project called 'Electronic Safe Box' which will protect our valuables and money safe from thieves.

**Working** - In this project I have used an Arduino board, a 16x16 lcd, a servo motor and a 4x4 keypad. In this Electronic safe, programing has been done in C++ language. After uploading the programing codes in Arduino board, the keypad on which we type the passcode sends the command to the arduino board for processing. By entering the correct password arduino board will actuate the servo motor which will open the safe and the lcd will also display 'Correct Password'. If the password is wrong then the lcd will display the message 'Wrong Password'. We don't need a physical key and a lock for this safes but we need a password to remember.

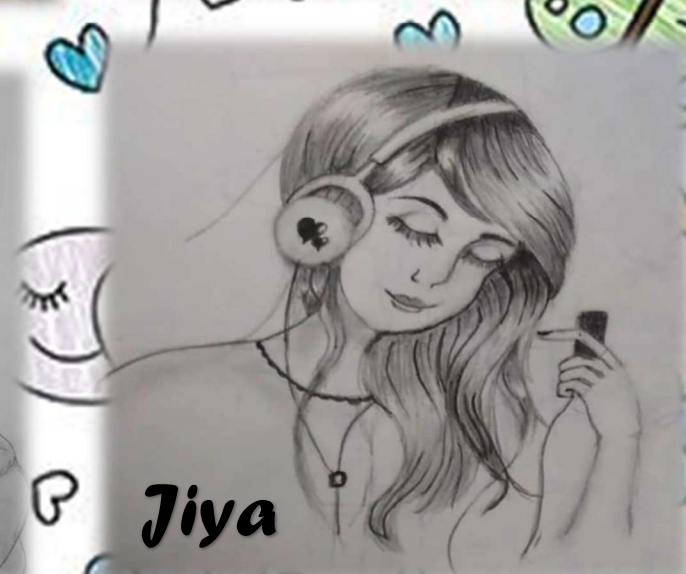

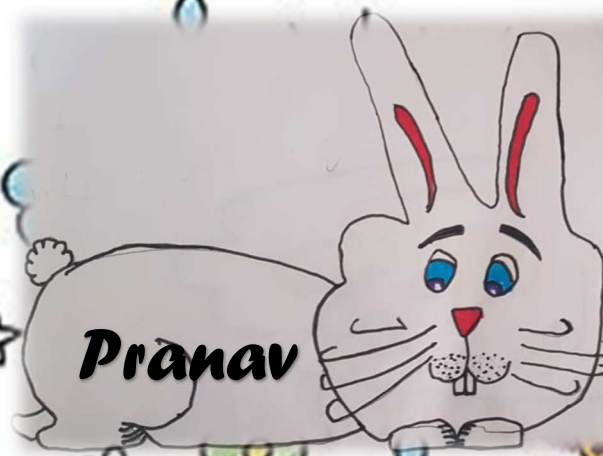

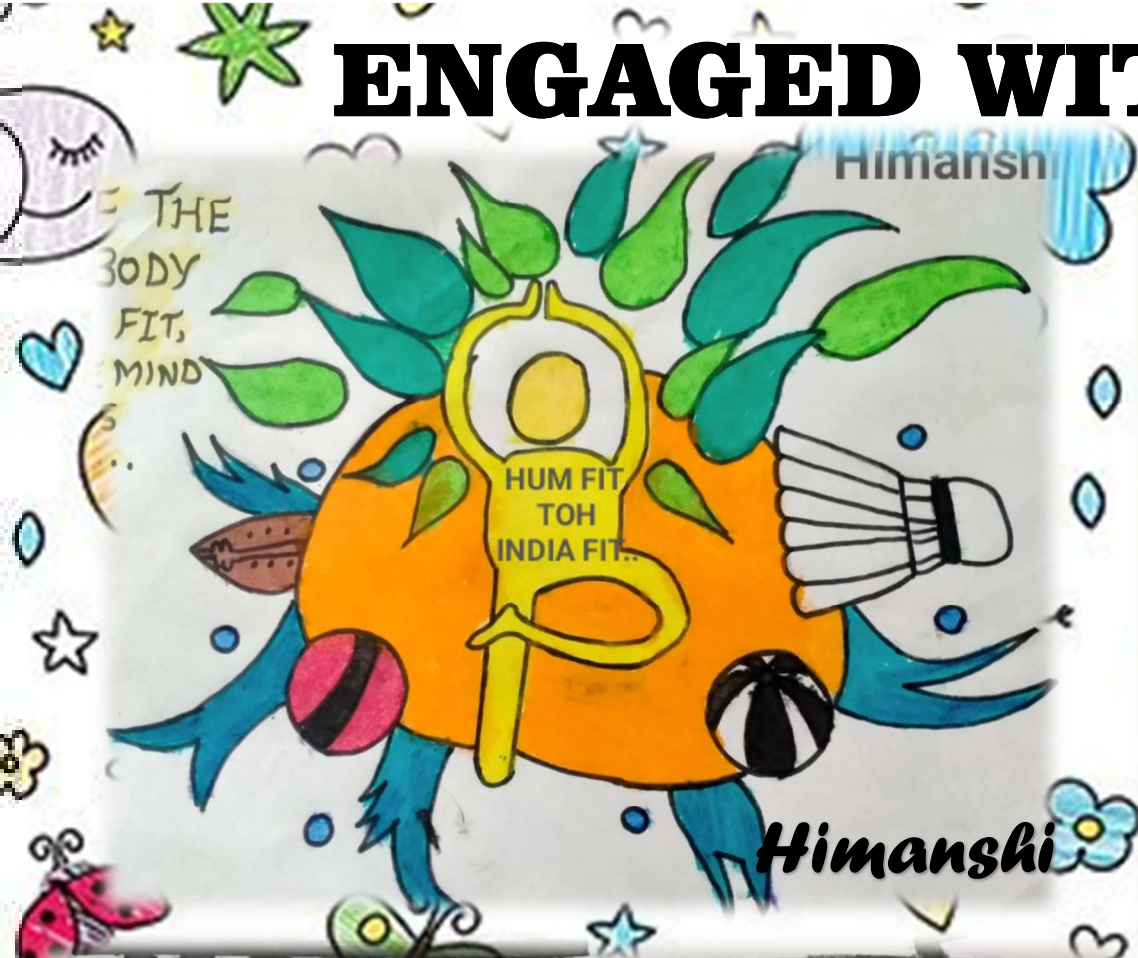
