



Christmas is also known as Christmastide that end on 6 January which means on the 12 day of Christmas during which people remember epiphany.



The also fast from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 24<sup>th</sup> December they eat only after midnight mass service.



## TECH SERIES

'Electronic Safe
Box'

Introduction - My name is Advit Kathuria and I am a student of Class 6th Sangam in Bhavan Vidyalaya Panchkula. As we all know thefts are happening in India. Therefore we all need to be cautious to keep our valuables in a safe. I have made a project called 'Electronic Safe Box' which will protect our valuables and money safe from thieves.

Working - In this project I have used an Arduino board, a 16x16 lcd, a servo motor and a 4x4 keypad. In this Electronic safe, programing has been done in C++ language. After uploading the programing codes in Arduino board, the keypad on which we type the passcode sends the command to the arduino board for processing. By entering the correct password arduino board will actuate the servo motor which will open the safe and the lcd will also display 'Correct Password'. If the password is wrong then the lcd will display the message 'Wrong Password'. We don't need a physical key and a lock for this safes but we need a password to remember.
