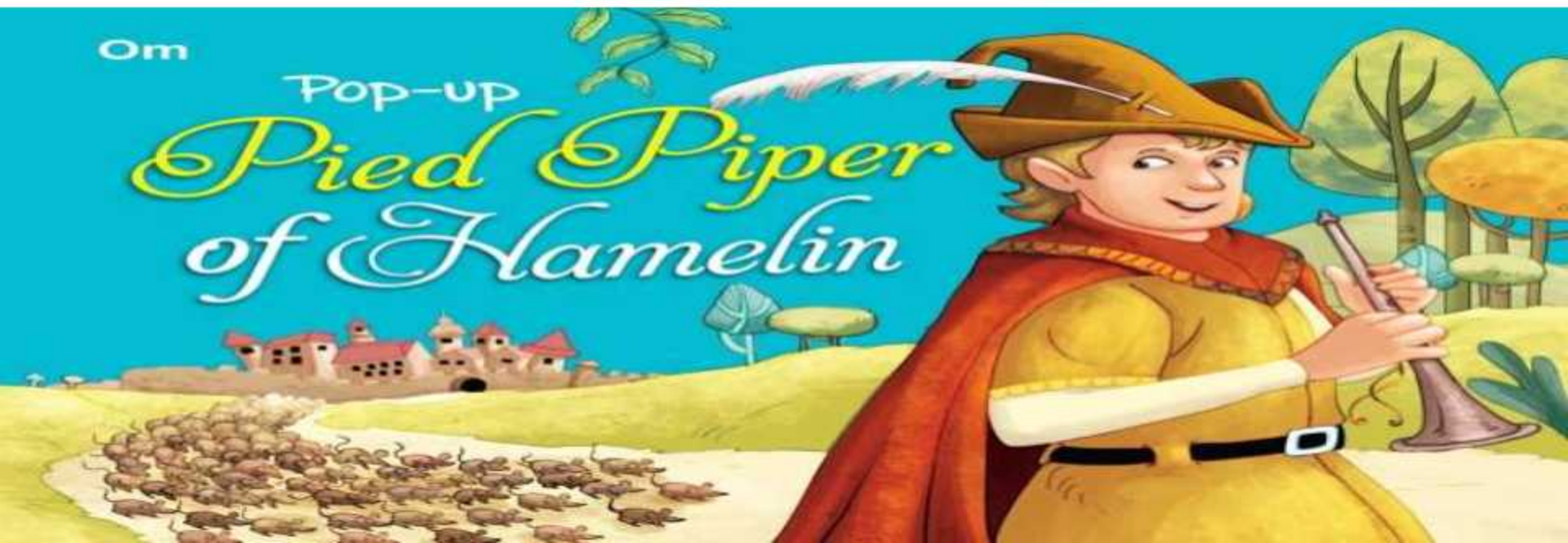


# TITLE - THE PIE PIPERS OF HAMELIN
