



"Putin considers the expansion of [NATO] to Eastern Europe and the Baltic states a direct threat to Russia's security, and the idea of Ukraine drawing closer to NATO—whether through the still far-off prospect of formal membership or by hosting NATO troops in the meantime—an existential red line." As a result, Russia is attempting to rewrite the history of the Cold War, and "tens of millions of Ukrainians" have become the unwitting hostages in Putin's attempt to wrest a better deal."












Vasant Panchami

Subhash Chandra Bose also participated in Civil Disobedience Movement.


➤ He was also a member of the Indian National Congress.

Makar Sakranti

- ❖ Makar Sankranti the pan India festival, known by various names is celebrated on 14th of January.
- It comes under solar month of Makara and lunar month of Magha as per the Hindu calendar. People fly kites under the sun to celebrate the festival in many parts of India
- Makar Sankranti is somewhat similar to the thanks giving festival celebrated in western part of the world.
- Makar Sankranti has the regional variations and is celebrated with different customs and traditions across India.

- As a part of important spiritual practice, on the day of festival people take holy bath in rivers for absolution of sins.
- ❖ Every 12 years, Kumbh Mela (a mass pilgrimage of belief) is organized and on the day of Makar Sankranti millions of people go to Prayag for the bath and offering of prayers to Lord Sun.
- Many people on the auspicious occasion of Makar Sankranti exchange sweets made up of jaggery and til to express love and joy.

- Army Day is celebrated every year on 15th January in recognition of India's first army commander in chief Lt. General KM Cariappa.
- Army Day is celebrated to pay tribute to our soldiers who sacrifice their lives to protect us.
- On 15 January 2019, India celebrated its 71st Army Day in New Delhi.
- Army Day is celebrated at every army command headquarters in India by paying tribute to martyred soldiers.
- Army Day celebration in capital New Delhi starts by paying tribute to our brave soldiers at the Amar Jawan Jyoti at India Gate.
- Parade showcasing the technology and the achievements of army are carried out.
- Bravery medals are awarded to soldiers for their sacrifice and valour on Army Day.
- Various competitions like painting, photography, slogan writing competitions are also organized on the occasion of Army Day.
- The transfer of power of army in the hands of Indian citizen on 15th January 1949 by the British General marked as Army Day in India.
- First time in the history of Indian army, a woman officer Lt. Bhawana Kasturi was in charge of Army Day parade 2019 comprising of 144 male officers.
