Interesting Facts About Janmashtami Celebrations In India



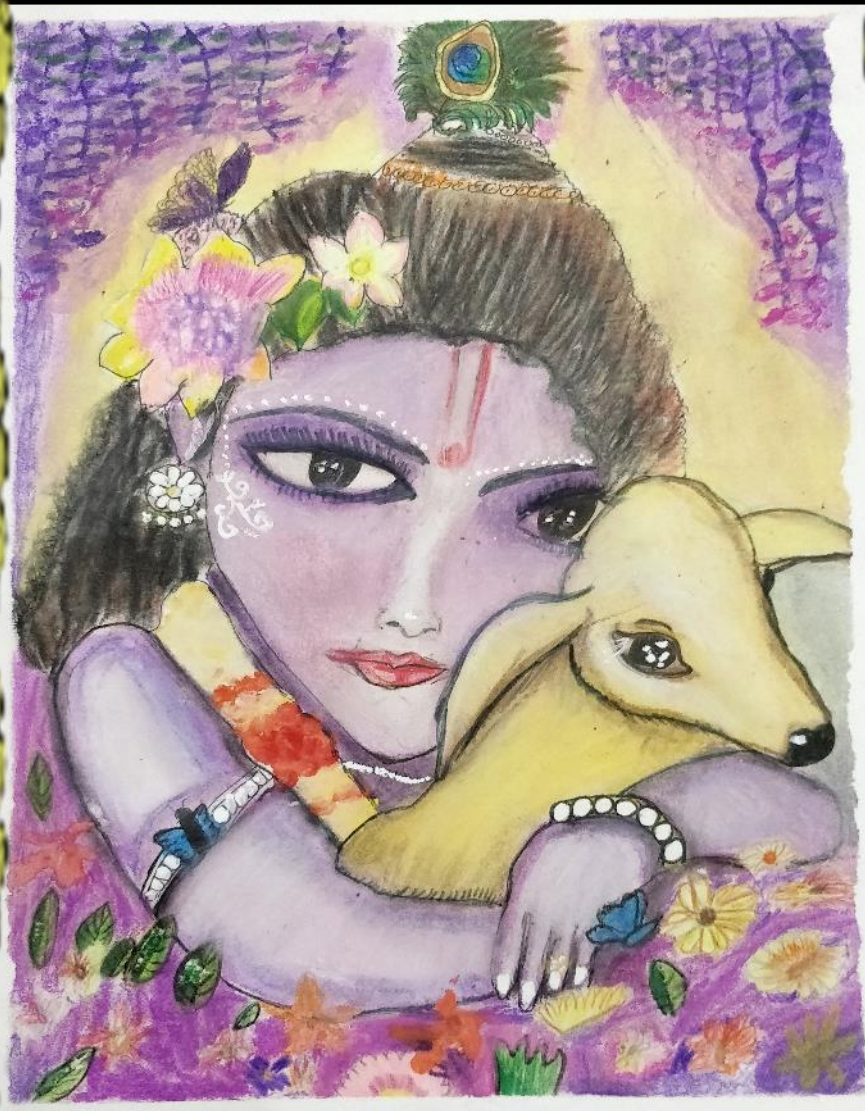
Stone painting made by Mihika

Global Warming

Global warming or climate change has today becoming a major threat to the mankind. The earth's temperature is on the rise and there are various reasons for it such as greenhouse gases emanating from carbon dioxide (CO_2) emissions, burning of fossil fuels or deforestation.

Impact of Greenhouse Gases

The rise in the levels of CO_2 leads to substantial increase in temperature. It is because CO_2 remains concentrated in the atmosphere for even hundred of years. Due to years like fossil fuel combustion for electricity, generation, transportation & heating human beings have contributed to increase in CO_2 concentration in the atmosphere.

Causes of Concern

According to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) global temperature is likely to rise about 1-3-5 Celsius by the year 2100. It has also suggested that the climate might warm by as much as 10 degrees Fahrenheit over the next 100 years.

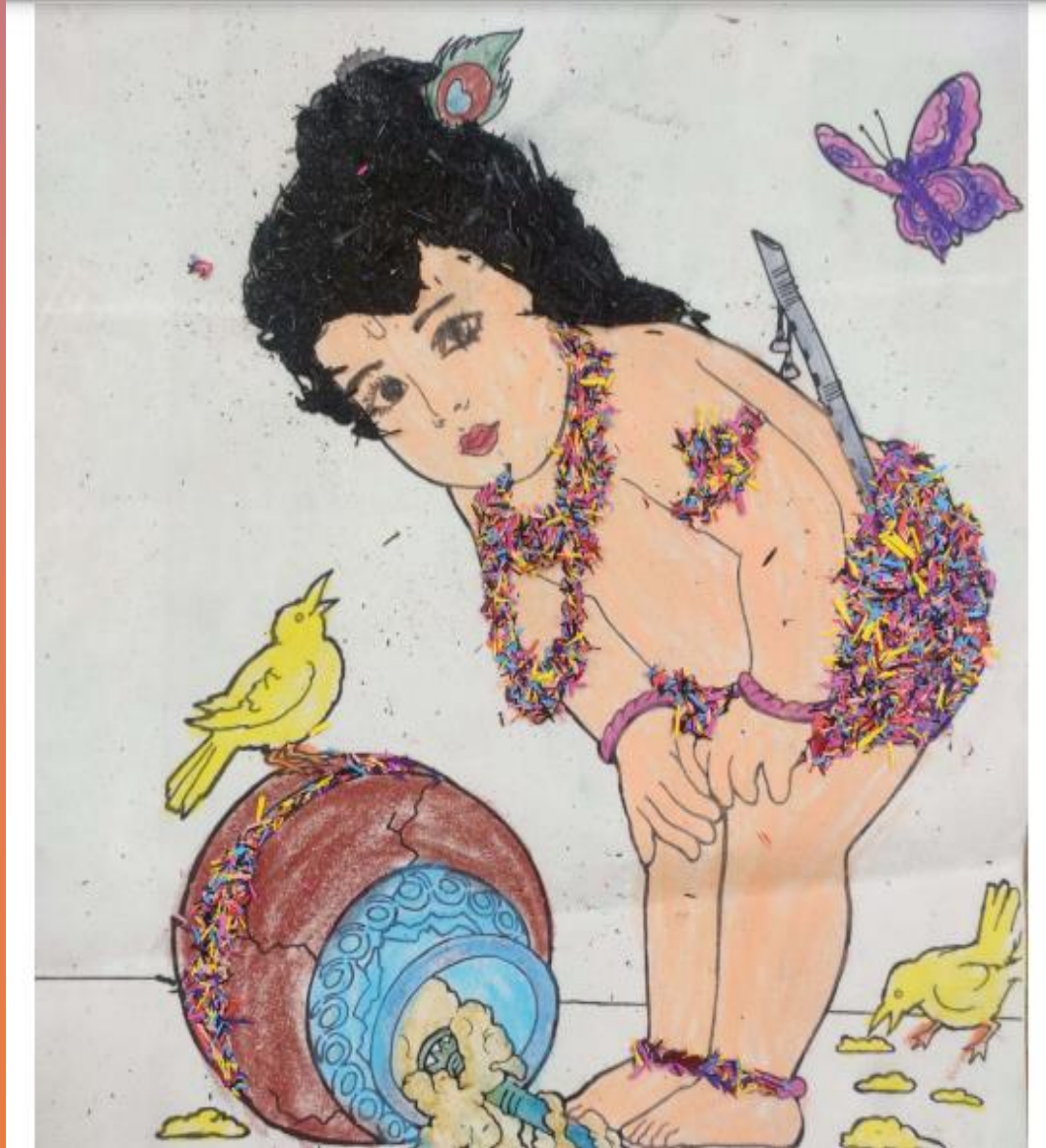

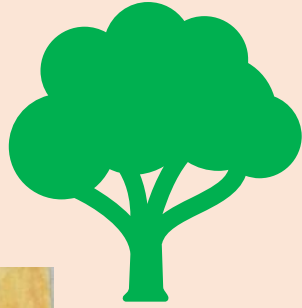

INDIAN FORCES

There are three forces which are always protecting Indian population



from external enemies.

1. Border Security Force :-The Border Security

Force (BSF) is India's Primary border guarding organisation on its border with Pakistan and Bangladesh. It comes under Ministry of Home Affairs. The BSF has its own cadre of officers but

its head, designated as a Director-General (DG), since its raising has been an officer from the Indian Police Service BSF has been termed as the *First Line of Defence of Indian Territories.*



2. Indian Navy :-The Indian Navy

is the naval branch of the Indian Armed Forces. The President of India is the Supreme Commander of the Indian Navy. The Chief of Naval Staff, a four star admiral, commands the navy. The primary objective of the navy is to safeguard the nation's maritime borders, and in conjunction with other Armed Forces of the union, act to deter or defeat any threats or aggression against the territory, people or maritime interests of India, both in war and peace



3. Indian Air Force

The **Indian Air Force (IAF)** is the air arm of the Indian Armed Forces. Its complement of personnel and aircraft assets ranks fourth amongst the air forces of the world. Its primary mission is to secure Indian airspace and to conduct aerial warfare during armed conflict. It was officially established on 8 October 1932 as an auxiliary air force of the British Empire which honoured India's aviation service during World War II with the prefix *Royal*. After India gained independence from United Kingdom in 1947, the name Royal Indian Air Force was kept and served in the name of . With the government's transition to a Republic in 1950, the prefix *Royal* was removed.

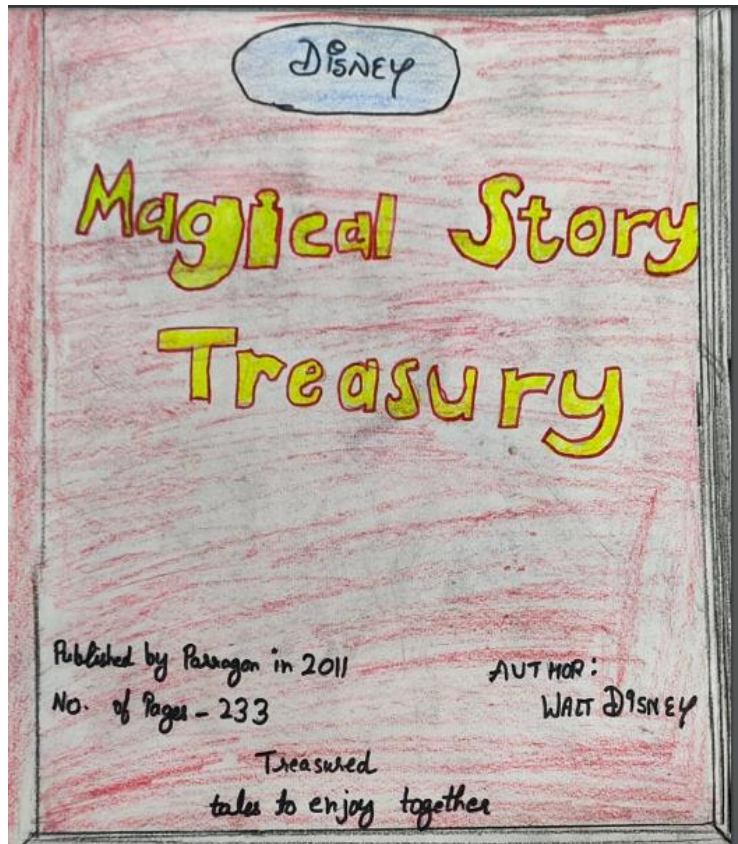
