
- Janmashtami celebrates the birth of Lord Krishna,


INDIAN FORCES

1.Border Security Force: The Border Security

Force (BSF) is India's Primary border guarding organisation on its border with Pakistan and Bangladesh. It

2.Indian Navy :- The Indian Navy is the naval

branch of the Indian Armed Forces. The President of India is the Supreme Commander of the Indian Navy. The Chief of Naval Staff, a four star admiral, commands the navy. The primary objective of the navy is to safeguard the nation's maritime borders, and in conjunction with other Armed Forces of the union, act to deter or defeat any threats or aggression

against the territory, people or maritime interests of India, both in war and peace



3.Indian Air Force

The Indian Air Force (IAF) is the air arm of the Indian Armed Forces. Its complement of personnel and aircraft assets ranks fourth amongst the air forces of the world. Its primary mission is to secure Indian airspace and to conduct aerial warfare during armed conflict. It was officially established on 8 October 1932 as an auxiliary air force of the British Empire which honoured India's aviation service during World War II with the prefix Royal. After India gained independence from United Kingdom in 1947, the name Royal Indian Air Force was kept and served in the name of . With the government's transition to a Republic in 1950, the prefix Royal was removed.







- On this day the sister ties rakhi on the wrist of their brothers and the brothers promise that they would always protect them.
