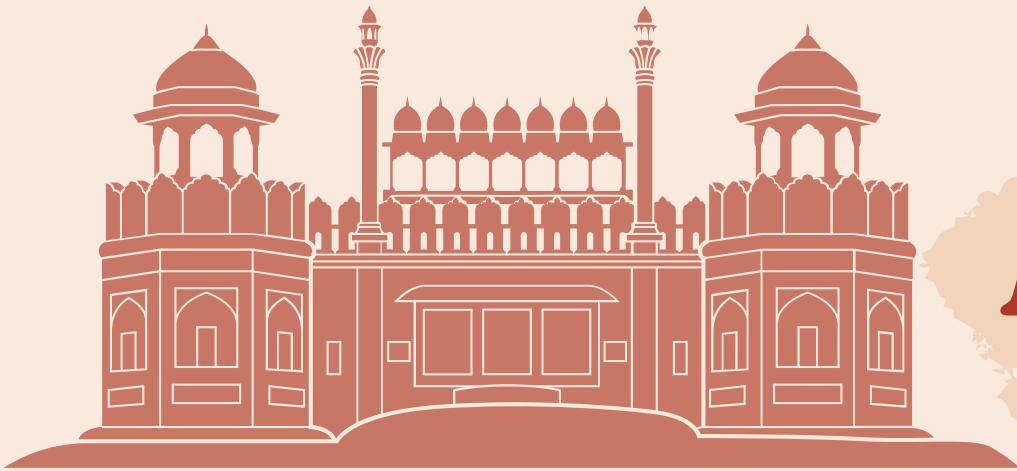

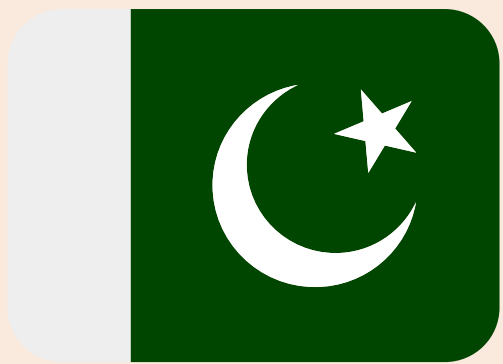




INDEPENDENCE DAY



INDIAN INDEPENDENCE DAY IS CELEBRATED ON 15TH OF AUGUST. IT IS A NATIONAL HOLIDAY. THE INDEPENDENCE DAY MARKS THE END OF BRITISH RULE IN THE YEAR 1947 AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FREE AND INDEPENDENT INDIA. IT IS ALSO THE PARTITION ANNIVERSARY OF THE SUBCONTINENT INTO TWO PARTS (INDIA AND PAKISTAN). BRITISH RULE BEGAN IN INDIA IN 1757 WHEN THE BRITISH ENGLISH EAST INDIA COMPANY WON THE BATTLE OF PLASSEY. AFTER THE REVOLT OF 1857 THE COUNTRY WAS DIRECTLY CONTROLLED BY THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT. THIS YEAR IT IS THE 75TH INDEPENDENCE DAY OF INDIA. ON THIS DAY EVERY YEAR THE PRIME MINISTER OF INDIA HOISTS THE FLAG ON RED FORT. WHICH IS FOLLOWED BY A MILITARY PARADE.

How is friendship day celebrated?

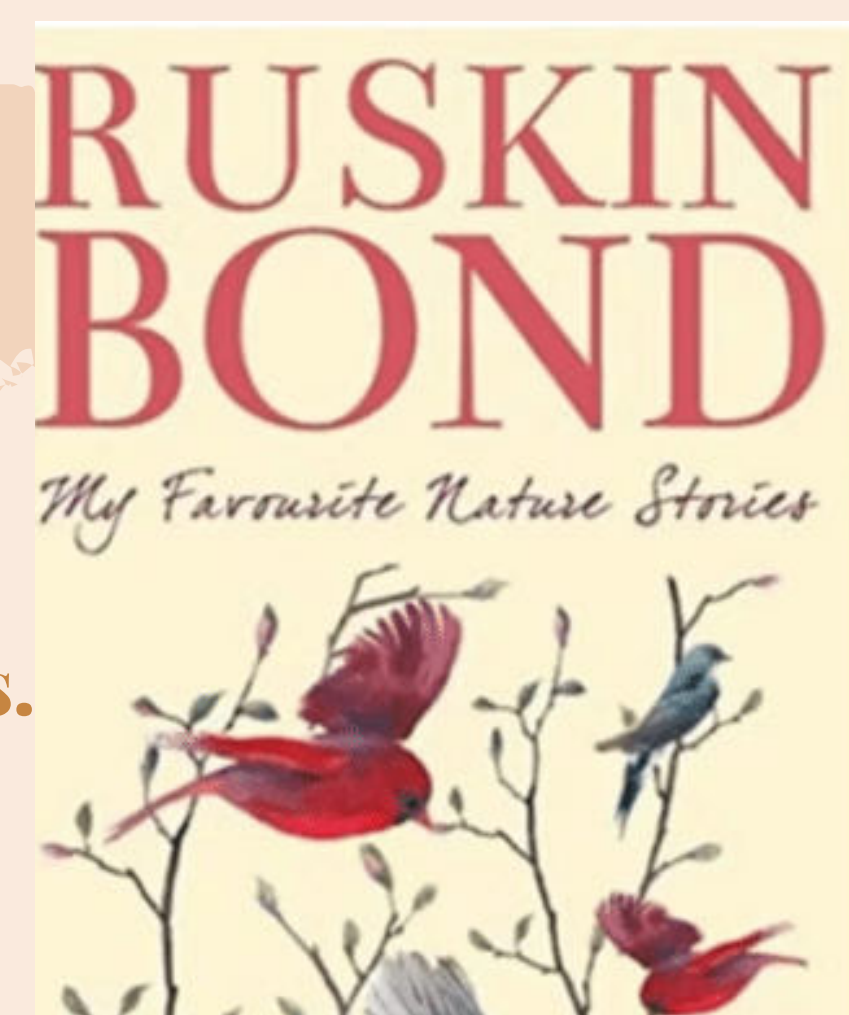
It usually celebrated by giving friends a friendship band, cards, gifts etc. Just as a sign of showing their bond and appreciating each other's presence.

***What is black hole? .**

The black hole is a place in space where gravity pulls so much that even light cannot get out. The gravity is so strong because matter has been squeezed into a tiny space. This can happen when a star is dying. Because no light can get out, people can't see black holes. They are invisible to the naked eye. Space telescopes with special tools can help find black holes. They can see how stars that are very close to black holes act differently than other stars.

How is it formed?

The smallest black holes appeared when the universe was formed (according to theory). They are called primordial black holes. Stellar black holes are made when the center of a very big star falls in upon itself, or collapses. When this happens, it causes a supernova. A supernova is an exploding star that blasts part of the star into space. Supermassive black holes were made at the same time as the galaxy they are in (according to theory).

NEWSPAPER

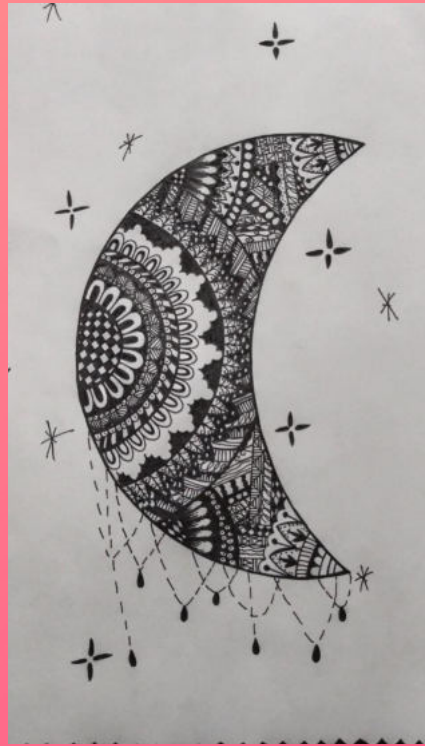

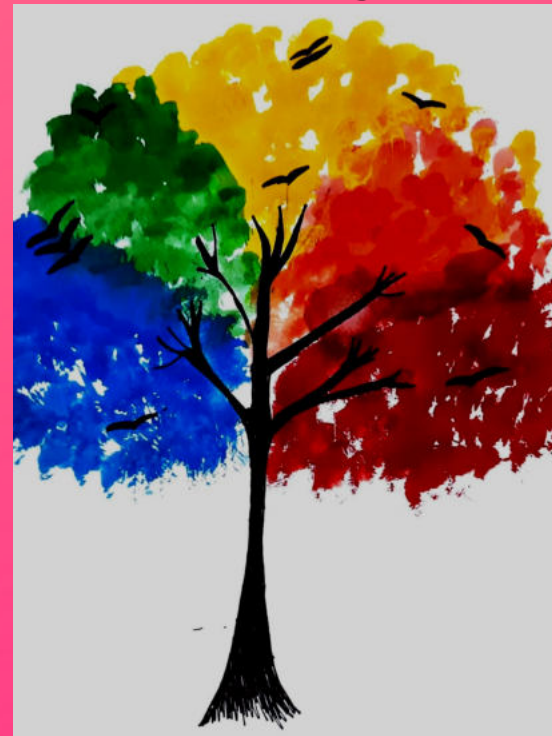

QUIT INDIA MOVEMENT

Gandhi was an extraordinary strategist of the twentieth-century mass political assembly process motivated by the self-dependent rule of the majority through a higher amount of non-violence methods.

They launched the “Bharat Chhodo Andolan” or the Quit India Movement in August 1942. A demand was declared for an immediate end of British rule by the All India Congress Committee, which was passed as a resolution on 8th August 1942 in Bombay. Every one of this nation started dreaming of a free India inspired by Gandhi ji’s slogan ‘Karo ya Maro’ (‘Do or Die’). Congress decided to arrange a mass movement on the enormous scale possible on non-violent lines.

As a result, the British government took a hasty decision and banned the Congress, and most of their leaders were arrested before they could even start deploying the people. But still, the people were unstoppable; there were exhibitions and rebellion all over the country

The people attacked the railway station, police stations and law courts as they were the symbols of the British Government. People even started their independent government in some places such as Ballia, Tamluk, Dharwar, Satara, Talcher, Balasore. These places were freed from British rules. The movement was most widespread in Bengal, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Odisha, Bombay, Andhra Pradesh. As a result the British responded with viciousness and the army was called to assist the police and lathi-charges, the firing was made to unarmed people. The rebels were arrested and tortured, and over sixty thousand people were jailed by the end of the year.

“Jai Prakash Narayan, S M Joshi, Achyut Patwardhan and Smt Sucheta Kripalani” were among the few leaders who were able escape from the arrest and went to hiding and tried to lead the mass movement. The people of the nation suffered very much during the Second World War also due to the terrible famine which took place in Bengal in AD 1943. More than thirty lakh people died due to the famine, and the Government did next to nothing about it. Quit India Movement was one of the renowned struggles of Indian History.

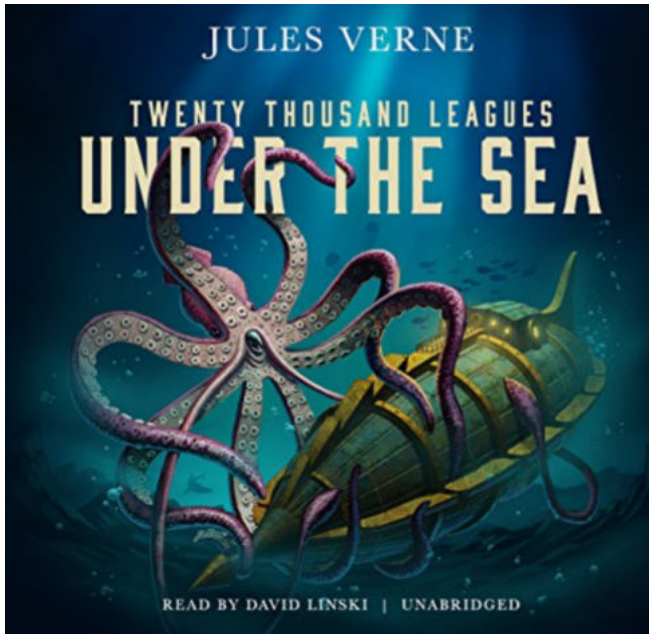

Book Review



Twenty Thousand Leagues Under The Sea is a classic book about submarine and sea expedition. We all heard about Captain Nemo or watched movies based on him.

Jules Verne creates an underwater world that breathes taking. Ned Land, a harpooner, Professor Pierre Aronnax, and his servant Conseil, with a team of men, set out to find a mysterious creature of the sea. But they were imprisoned at Nautilus by Captain Nemo. He treats them well, but they are not allowed to go back to land. Captain Nemo is generous but ruthless at the same time. His secrets attract the professor, and soon he becomes part of Captain Nemo's expedition.

They traveled different seas, unveiled magnificent creatures, and ruined cities. While the the professor was pleased with the events, Ned Land wants to escape the submarine. The expression dead men tell no tale fits here because if one has to leave the Nautilus, they should be stagnant.

I presume it is one reason why Captain Nemo bestows almost all the ship's functions with the professor. What will happen when the professor and Ned Land share different notions of their states? Is Captain Nemo actually a good man, or is it all just a pretense? The professor narrates the story, which makes it exciting because his character is inquisitive all the time. Conseil's personality seems to be like a slave because he has no opinions; he is always ready to do whatever his master says. While Ned Land firmly felt like he was just there to remind the professor that they don't belong to Nautilus. Captain Nemo is the real deal; he is secretive, sensitive, brutal, stubborn, and fearless. Professor tried a lot to know why he built the submarine, why he left the land, and hate politics so much, but the Caption has a persona that no one could decode.

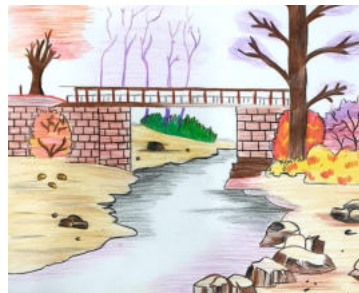
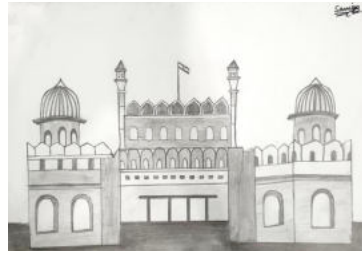

कृष्ण जन्माष्टमी का व्रत

यह भारत के विभिन्न स्थानों पर भिन्न-भिन्न तरह से मनाया जाता है। इस उत्सव पर ज्यादातर लोग पूरा दिन व्रत रह कर, पूजा के लिए, घरों में बाल कृष्ण की प्रतिमा पालने में रखते हैं। पूरा दिन भजन कीर्तन करते तथा उस मौसम में उपलब्ध सभी प्रकार के फल और सात्विक व्यंजन से भगवान को भोग लगा कर रात्रि के 12:00 बजे पूजा अर्चना करते हैं।

कृष्ण जन्माष्टमी की विशेष पूजा सामग्री का महत्व

पूजा हेतु सभी प्रकार के फलाहार, दूध, मक्खन, दही, पंचामृत, धनिया मेवे की पंजीरी, विभिन्न प्रकार के हलवे, अक्षत, चंदन, रोली, गंगाजल, तुलसीदल, मिश्री तथा अन्य भोग सामग्री से भगवान का भोग लगाया जाता है। खीरा और चना का इस पूजा में विशेष महत्व है। ऐसी मान्यता है जन्माष्टमी के व्रत का विधि पूर्वक पूजन करने से मनुष्य मोक्ष प्राप्त कर वैकुण्ठ (भगवान विष्णु का निवास स्थान) धाम जाता है।

निष्कर्ष

1 Tbsp Rose Water (optional)

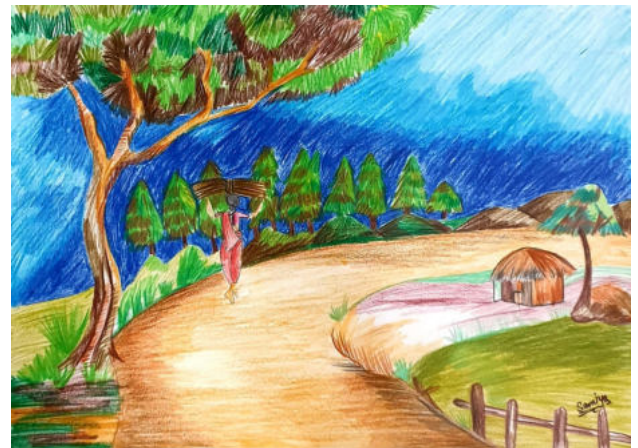
Method

Fact The Monsoon Out

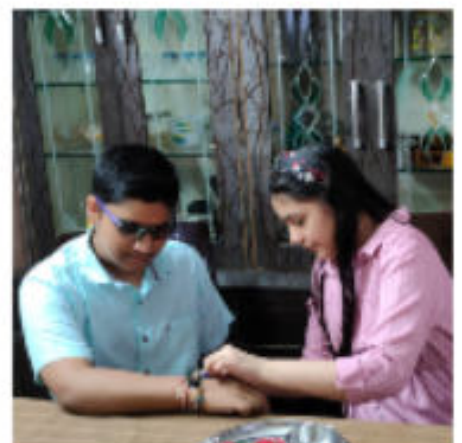
- The name 'monsoon' is believed to be derived from the Arabic word 'mausim'. Mausim means a shift in season or wind.

- 2020 is the second consecutive year of 'above normal' monsoon, with seasonal rainfall of 109%.
- Falling during the month of Saavan - Raksha Bandhan, Teej, Onam, and Nag Panchami are a few festivals celebrated in India during the monsoon months.
- A monsoon always blows from a cold region to a warm region.
- There are nearly 500,000 lightning strikes during a monsoon.
