HARYANA DAY : 1 NOVEMBER__



1. Haryana was established on November 1, 1966 and we celebrate *Haryana Day* on this *day*.
2. Haryana Day is always celebrated on November 1st as it marks the formation of the state of Haryana on this day in 1966. In April 1966, the Indian government set up the Shah Commission to review the existing state of Punjab and determine the boundaries of the new state of Haryana by considering the languages spoken by the local people. The commission delivered its recommendations at the end of May 1966 and Haryana state was created on November 1st 1966.
3. The day is celebrated by people of Haryana and is a regional holiday in the state.
4. The name Haryana means 'the land of God'. In Sanskrit, Hari means God and Ayana is home.
5. Haryana is the 21st largest state out of 29 in terms of area.
6. It has the third-highest per capita income in India and is one of the most economically developed regions in South Asia.


