GENERAL BIPIN SINGH RAWAT WAS AN INDIAN MILITARY OFFICER. HE WAS A GENERAL OF THE INDIAN ARMY. HE WAS BORN BORN ON 16 MARCH 1958 IN PAURI, UTTARAKHAND. HIS FATHER, LAXMAN SINGH RAWAT ALSO SERVED IN THE INDIAN ARMY WAS GENERAL BIPIN SINGH RAWAT FIRST CHIEF OF INDIA

DEFENCE STAFF (CDS). HE SERVED AS THE CDS OF THE INDIAN ARMED FORCES FROM JANUARY 2020 TILL HIS DEATH. HE RECEIVED HIS FORMAL EDUCATION AT CAMBRIAN HALL SCHOOL IN DEHRADUN AND ST. EDWARD'S SCHOOL IN SHIMLA. HE LATER JOINED THE NATIONAL DEFENSE ACADEMY, KHADAKWASLA AND THE INDIAN MILITARY ACADEMY, DEHRADUN, WHERE HE WAS AWARDED THE SWORD OF HONOUR. IN JANUARY 979, HE GOT HIS FIRST APPOINTMENT IN THE ARMY IN MIZORAM AND DURING HIS DEPLOYMENT IN THE NEFA AREA, HE LED THE BATTALION.

RAWAT TOOK OVER AS THE VICE CHIEF OF THE ARMY STAFF ON 01 SEPTEMBER 2016. THIS WAS SOON FOLLOWED BY THE 27TH VENUE IN DECEMBER 2016.

APPOINTED AS CHIEF OF ARMY STAFF. HE WAS ALSO THE HONORARY GENERAL OF THE NEPALESE ARMY. WITH A CAREER SPANNING NEARLY 43 YEARS

DURING THIS HE RECEIVED PARAM VISHISHT SEVA MEDAL, UTTAM YUDH SEVA MEDAL, ATI VISHISHT SEVA MEDAL, YUDH SEVA MEDAL, SENA MEDAL,







<u>Shaheed-i-Azam Sardar Udham Singh</u>

Udham Singh, born on 26 December 1899 in Punjab, was a freedom fighter and the Punjab revolutionary who played an important role in the struggle of freedom. He because of his courage and bravery will always remain as a freedom fighter who tried to suppress the British regime. He is also referred to as 'Shaheed - I - Azam Sardar Udham Singh'. Sardar Tehal Singh Jammu, the father of Udham Singh, was a railway crossing watchman in the village called Upali. After his father died, he was taken in by the orphanage called Central Khalsa orphanage Putlighar in Amritsar. There he taught about the Sikh initiatory rights, and he received the name 'Udham Singh'.

He was greatly influenced by the revolutionary ideas and Bhagat Singh. In 1924, he became the part of Ghadar party. He jailed for keeping arms illegally, and his Ghadar party paper was also confiscated.

Udham Singh as a part of the orphanage was serving water to the crowd at Jallianwala Bagh. It was at that time General Dyer ordered the troops to leave, and he opened fire on the people without giving them a warning. This led to the killing of the large number of men, women and children, approx 1,800 and around 1,200 were wounded. He got disturbed by this incident and decided to take revenge. As revenge, Udham Singh decided to kidnap general dyer on 13th March 1940. When he tried to kill General O' Dwyer who was arrived at a joint meeting at Caxton Hall, London; he was arrested.





COMICRON

The Omicron variant of COVID-19 has been called a variant of concern by WHO based on the evidence that it has several mutations that may have an impact on how it behaves. There is still substantial uncertainty regarding Omicron and a lot of research underway to evaluate its transmissibility, severity and reinfection risk. When a virus is circulating widely and causing numerous infections, the likelihood of the virus mutating increases. The more opportunities a virus has to spread, the more opportunities it has to undergo changes. New variants like Omicron are a reminder that the COVID-19 pandemic is far from over. It is therefore essential that people get the vaccine when available to them and continue to follow existing advice on preventing the spread of the virus, including physical distancing, wearing masks, regular handwashing and keeping indoor areas well ventilated. It is also crucial that vaccines and other public health measures are accessible everywhere. Vaccine inequity leaves lower income countries - many of them in Africa – at the mercy of COVID-19. Well-supplied countries must urgently deliver the doses they promised. The Omicron variant has now been detected in many countries around the world. WHO reports that Omicron is probably in most countries, even if it hasn't been detected yet






VIJAY DIWAS




The end of the war also resulted in the unilateral and unconditional surrender of the Pakistan Army and subsequent secession of East Pakistan into Bangladesh.


VIJAY DIWAS


- Topic of this time's Prahelika was table calendar making. Students will be divided into 4 groups, six students in each group representing their house.



THE DIARY OF A YOUNG GIRL BY:- ANNE FRANK

The diary of a young girl is a singular, moving look at world war 2 from a young girl's perspective. In 1942, during the Nazi occupation of Holland a Jewish girl named Anne Frank receives a blank diary for her 13 birthday. Treating the empty book like an imaginary friend named "Kitty". She writes faithfully, describing her fondest wishes and feelings. Anne Frank couldn't have known, when she wrote these words, that her musings would become primary sources of information about life during the holocaust. She is also a remarkably thoughtful narrator, and her diary is as entertaining as it is significant to the historical document. Though the events within the diary offer only a glimpse of the horrors inflicted on the Jewish people by the Nazi's, the diary paints a vivid picture of human nature in the time of war. There are many important messages in this book, but the most important message is that all people have the right to live in freedom. Her story shows us that just because people maybe a different religion or race, doesn't mean that they should be treated differently. When her family is forced into hiding to avoid capture by the German police, the book becomes like a lifeline for Anne, who describes the fear, hunger, longing and boredom she experiences during two years living in the place she calls the "Secret Annex". At the age of fifteen Anne, her family, and others living with them where deported to Nazi's concentration camp. A typhus epidemic spread through the camp in 1945, it is believed that she became ill and died after sometime. Her father Otto frank was the only survivor of the family, he returned to Amsterdam after the war. Anne became one of the most discussed Jewish victims of the holocaust due to enormous popularity of her diary. I suggest all the young readers as well as all the people interested in knowing the ancient holocaust history must read this book.







