

#### Mauna Loa in Hawaii




#### BACKGROUND OF THE TRAGEDY

Japan was a fierce enemy of the US and its allies — Britain, China and the Soviet Union — during the World War II. Japanese forces decided to take an aim at Indo-china with the intention of capturing the oil-rich areas of the East Indies. The Japanese had publicly stated their intent to fight to the bitter end, and were using factics such as Kamikaze attacks, in which pilots would suicide-dive against US warships. U.S. President Harry Truman ordered to destroy the cities to force Japan to surrender in WW2. The consent of the United Kingdom was obtained for the bombing under the Quebec Agreement and orders were issued for atomic bombs to be used against Japanese cities. This was because the aim was to destroy Japan's ability to fight wars.






