Nuts are fattening.

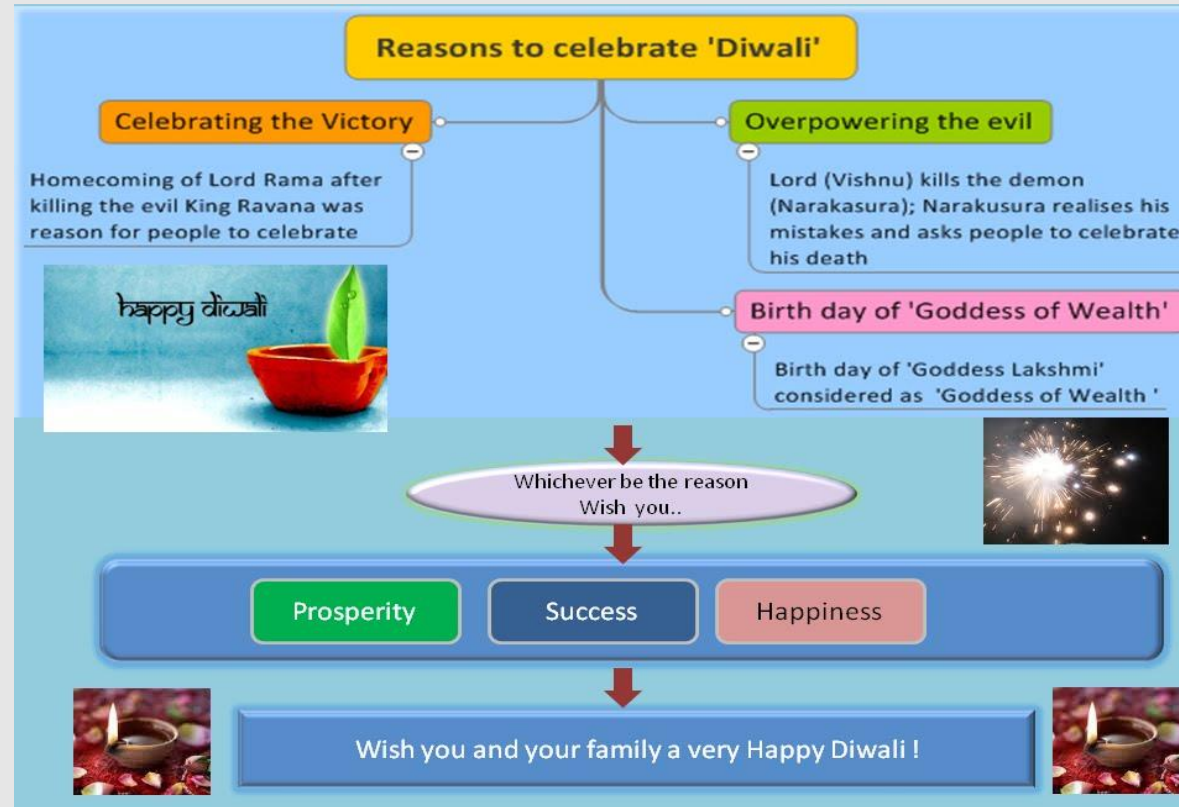

Dussehra

- **Dussehra, also called Dasara or Vijayadashami, in Hinduism, holiday marking the triumph of Rama, an avatar of Vishnu, over the 10-headed demon king Ravana, who abducted Rama's wife, Sita. The festival's name is derived from the Sanskrit words *dasha* (“ten”) and *hara* (“defeat”). Symbolizing the victory of good over evil, Dussehra is celebrated on the 10th day of the month of Ashvina (September–October), the seventh month of the Hindu calendar, with the appearance of the full moon, an event called the “bright fortnight” (*shukla paksha*). Dussehra coincides with the culmination of the nine-day Navratri festival and with the tenth day of the Durga Puja festival. For many, it marks the beginning of preparation for Diwali, which occurs 20 days after Dussehra.**

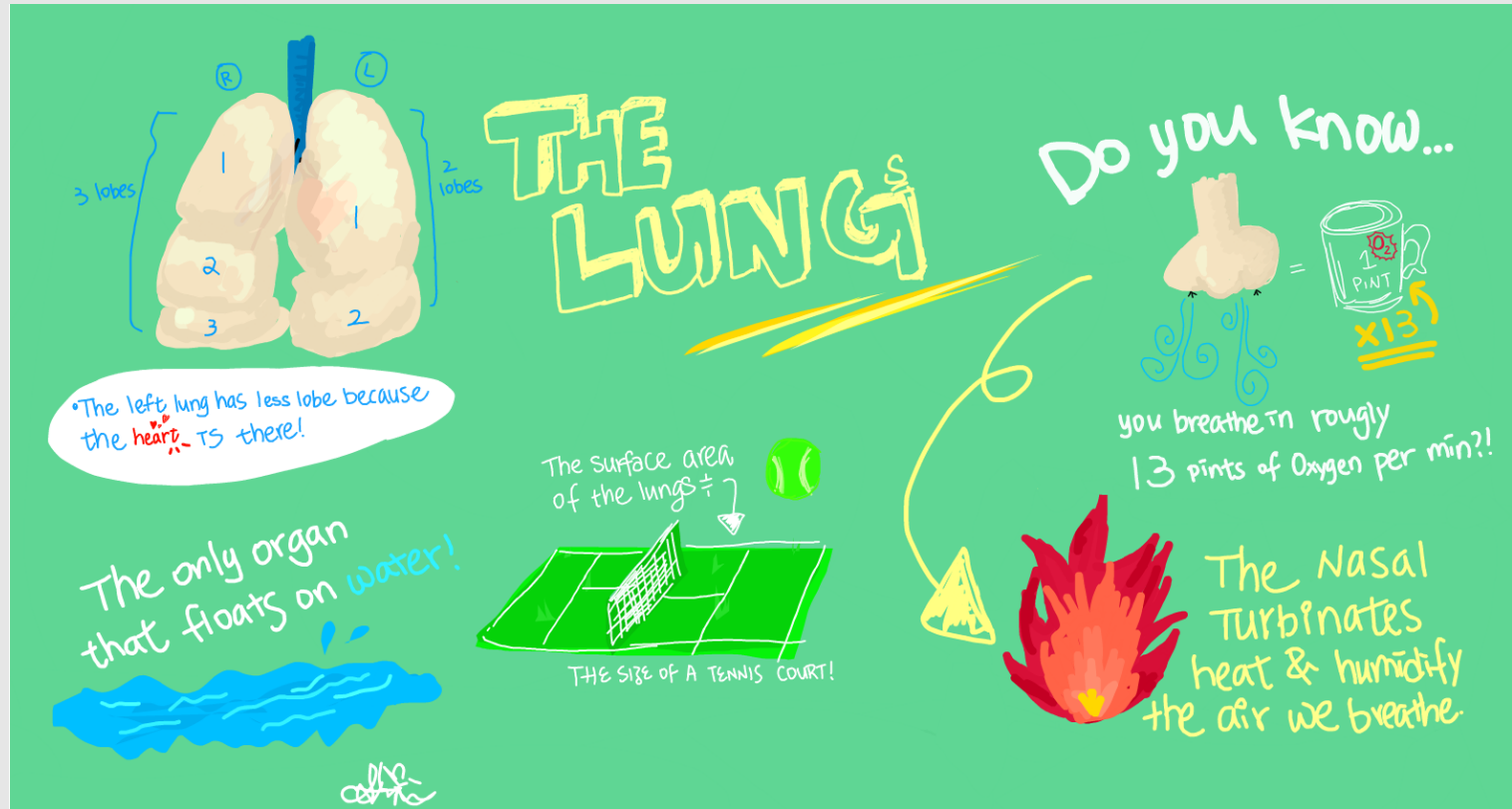

Book Review

The White Tiger by Aravind Adiga

The White Tiger, paints a vivid and disturbing picture of life in the strikingly different cultures that comprise modern India. Home to more than 15 percent of the world's population, the country has grown to become an economic power, and yet vast numbers of its inhabitants have little to show for its prosperity. The conflict created by that reality propels this riveting tale.

Son of a rickshaw puller, the neo conventional protagonist from the book, The White Tiger, Babram Hahvai, narrates the actual story connected with his lifestyle and his movement through darkness in order to attain light. In a tongue-in-cheek manner he unravels how the ruling capitalist ideology never ever allows the actual poverty stricken to come up into the limelight. The publisher of the book is Harper Collins India Limited.

Summary of the book

In essentially the most impoverished along with destitute villages in the Indian subcontinent, a young boy is hungry for knowledge. However, the circumstances plus the cultural disorders prevalent causes it to become almost unattainable for him to do so. Prevailing among the limited opportunities, the son of a rickshaw-puller, find a means to escape the vice-grip associated with his family and he becomes the driver for the son of a wealthy landowner. Brilliant and quick-witted, he quickly relates to terms while using the divide concerning the rich and the poor. He realizes that he should now break the centuries-old shackles and should flee intended for his existence and vie his old life to satisfy his fate.

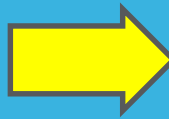

Ganesh Chaturthi Article

Ganesh Chaturthi, also called Vinayaka Chaturthi, in Hinduism, 10-day Festival marking the birth of the elephant-headed deity Ganesha the god of prosperity and wisdom. It begins on the fourth day (*chaturthi*) of the month of Bhadrapada (August–September), the sixth month of the Hindu Calendar.

At the start of the festival, idols of Ganesha are placed on raised platforms in homes or in elaborately decorated outdoor tents. The worship begins with the *pranapratishta*, a ritual to invoke life in the idols, followed by *shhodhanopachara*, or the 16 ways of paying tribute. Amid the chanting of Vedic hymns from religious texts like the Ganesha Upanishad, the idols are anointed with red Sandalwood paste and yellow and red flowers. Ganesha is also offered coconut, jaggery, and 21 *modaks* (sweet dumplings), considered to be Ganesha's favourite food.

At the conclusion of the festival, the idols are carried to local rivers in huge processions accompanied by drumbeats, devotional singing, and dancing. There they are immersed, a ritual symbolizing Ganesha's homeward journey to Mount Kailas—the abode of his parents, Shiva and Parvati.

Ganesh Chaturthi assumed the nature of a gala public celebration when the Maratha ruler Shivaji (c. 1630–80) used it to encourage nationalist sentiment among his subjects, who were fighting the Mughals. In 1893, when the British banned political assemblies, the festival was revived by the Indian nationalist leader Bal Gangadhar Tilak.

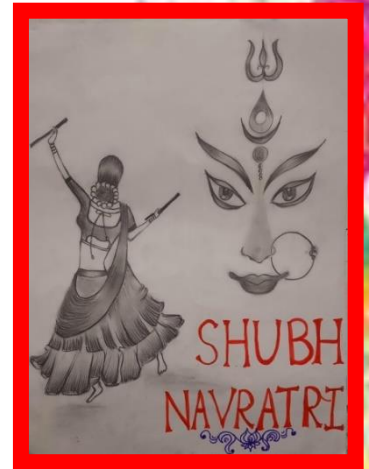

गणेश चतुर्थी

गणेश चतुर्थी का त्योहार भगवान श्री गणेश के जन्मेत्सव के रूप में मनाया जाता है। विदेह ने यह त्योहार पूरे देश में मनाया जाता है। लेकिन पश्चिमी भारत खास कर महाराष्ट्र में इसकी उत्सुक देखी जाती होती है। यह त्योहार 11 दिनों तक चलने वाला सबसे लंबा त्योहार होता है तथा हर साल अगस्त या सितंबर के महीने में मनाया जाता है। चौथा चतुर्थी के कुछ दिनों पहले ही बालगों में रौनक शुरू हो जाती है। यह उत्सव चतुर्थी के दिन घर या सड़क में सुर्ति स्थापना से शुरू होता है तथा अन्ततः चतुर्थी अर्थात् 11वें दिन गणेश विमर्जन के साथ समाप्त होता है।

रक्षा बंधन का शाब्दिक अर्थ रक्षा करने वाला बंधन (धारा) है। इस वर्ष में बहने अपने इर्द गैर के कलाई पर रक्षा सूत्र बांधती है और अपने जीवन भर इनकी रक्षा करने का वचन देती है। हम दोनों एक दूसरे को राखी बांध कर जीवन भर एक दूसरे की रक्षा करने का वचन देते हैं। यह आजका माह के पूर्णिमा में मने वाला हिंदू तथा अन्य धर्म का प्रमुख त्योहार है। पुराने समय में घर की छोटी बेटों द्वारा मिट्टी की राखी बांधी जाती थी। आज महाराष्ट्र द्वारा देश की सुरक्षा में तैयार सैनिकों को भी पर जबर राखी बांधी जाती है क्योंकि वह बाह्य सैनिक से हमको रक्षा करते हैं। इस दिन बाजारों में राखी और मिठाइयों की दुकानों पर काफी भीड़ होती है। राखी का त्योहार ईर्द बहन को भावनात्मक तौर पर जोड़ता है।

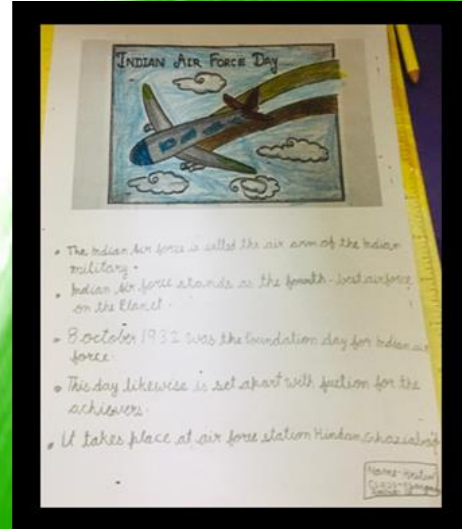

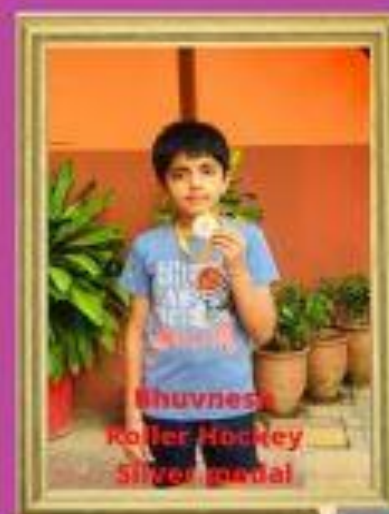
