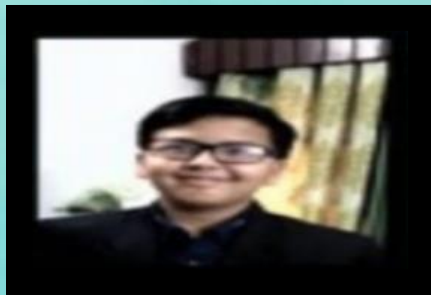

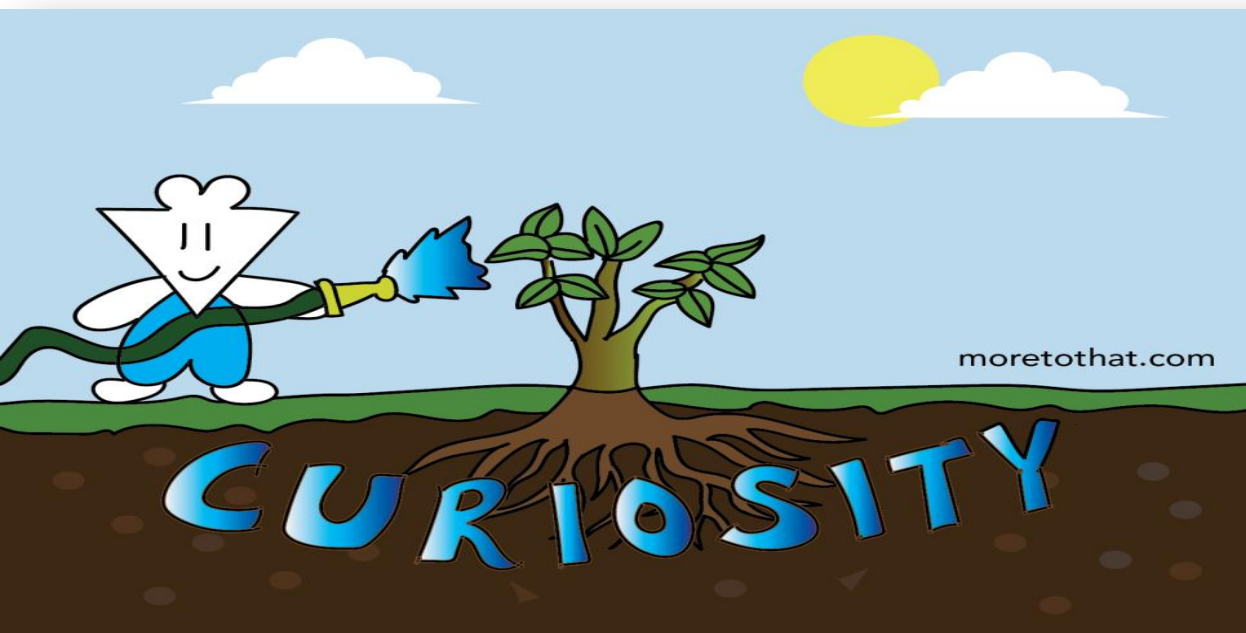
Dear learners,

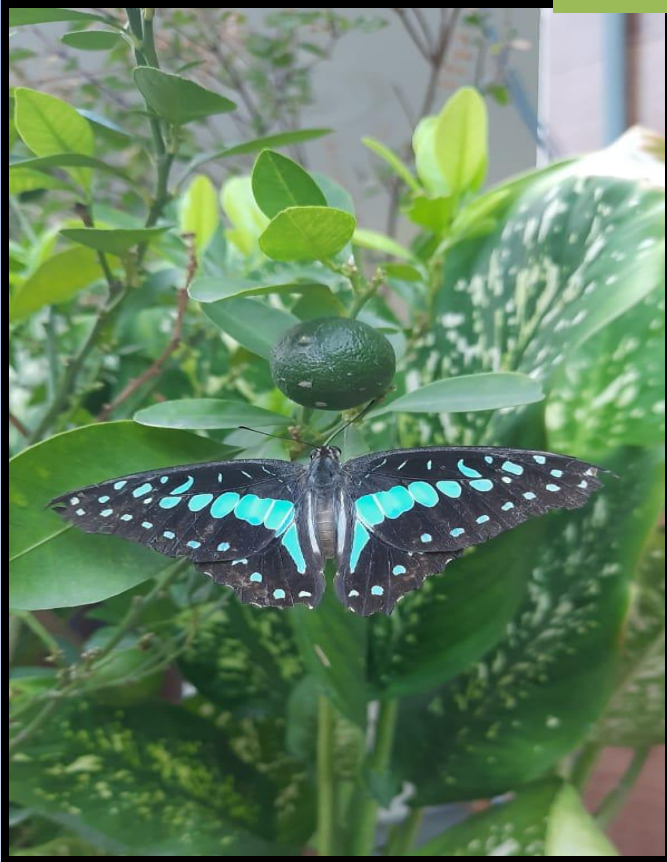

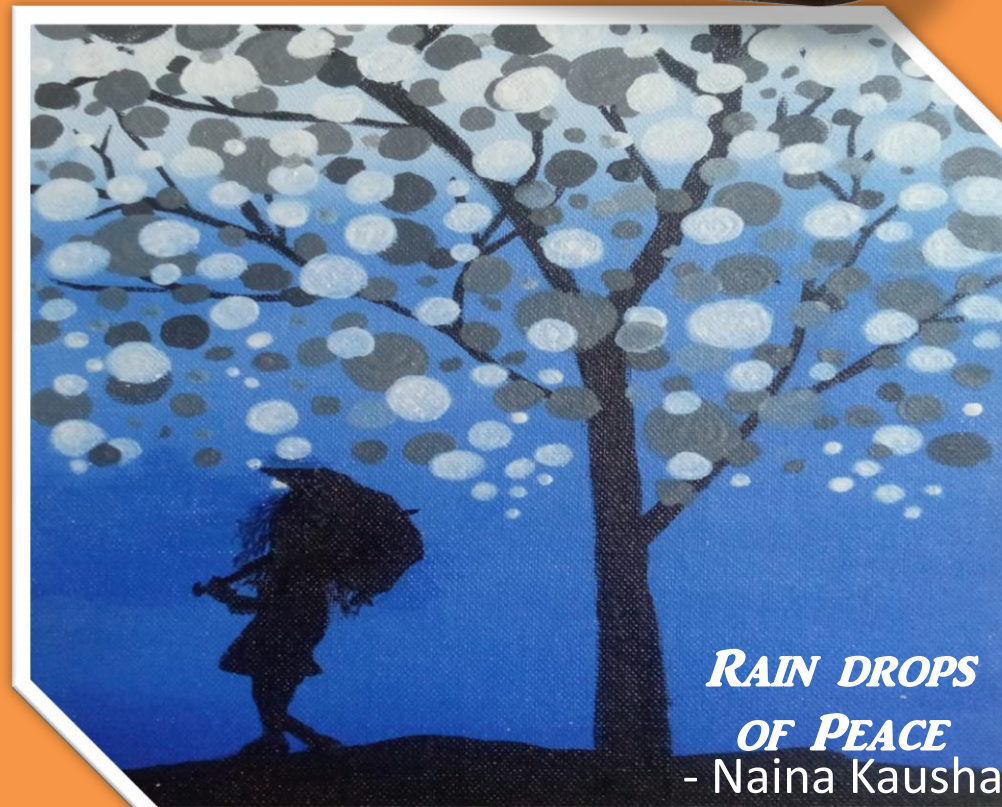

- Rivers play a great significance in the lives of the people. The importance of rivers cannot be ignored. Rivers play a very important part of our lives as we will not be able to drink water without rivers. Industrial work depends on river water, as it provides the power sources for the machinery, and in return the disposal for the non-toxic waste material from the industry makes the river dirty. Rivers provide water to the farmers for growth. It helps to make the infertile land, fertile again, so it also there for the growth of vegetation. Rivers are a primary source for the growth of agriculture, which is the backbone of a country.

THE IMPORTANCE OF RIVERS IS AS FOLLOWS :

- Rivers carry nutrients to all the areas around the earth. Rivers play a very important part in the water cycle, which act as a drainage channel for surface water. It drains nearly 75% of the earth's land surface. Rivers provide food and habitat for many of the earth's organisms. Also, many trees and plants grow by rivers. Otters, Ducks, and beavers make their homes on the river banks. Plants like bulrushes and Reeds grow along the river banks. Some animals use the river for food and drink. Birds like kingfishers eat small fish from the river. Animals such as antelopes, lions, and elephants drink water from rivers. Animals like bears catch fish from rivers. Many different species of wildlife are present in River deltas. Mammals, birds, and Insects use the delta for their homes and for food.
