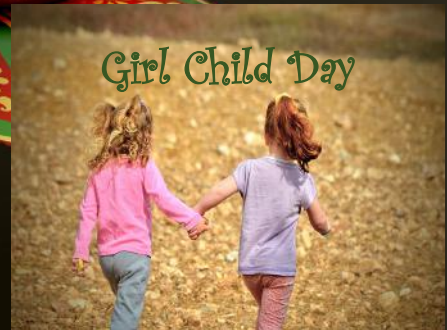

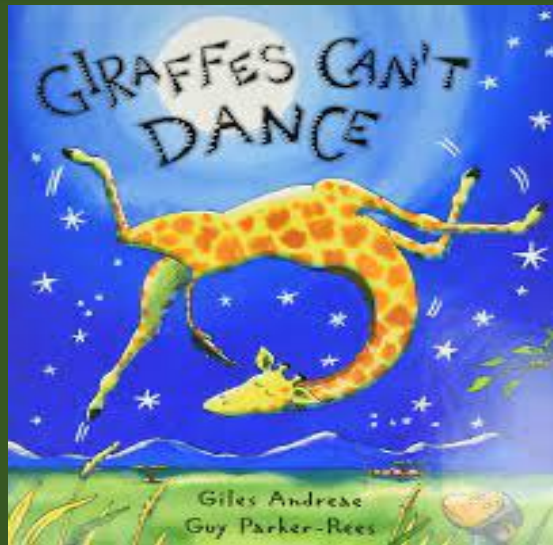
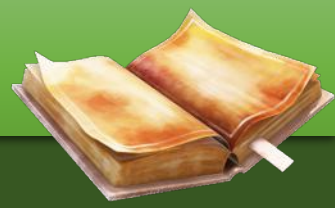

During the annual *jungle dance*, all animals showed some real mean moves, and poor Gerald got teased by other creatures and was hooted off the dance floor.
- ❖ Gerald got upset and was leaving for home when he comes across a cricket. Now this wise little creature gave him a piece of advice saying, "Sometimes, when you're different, you just need a different song." So to the sound of the trees and the wind, Gerald starts to move. He listened to the sound around him and starts swaying gently, swishing lightly, and did a bit of circling. With the guidance of the cricket, Gerald is able to learn how to dance and the other animals in the jungle were left in awe.

And the sound of crackers.

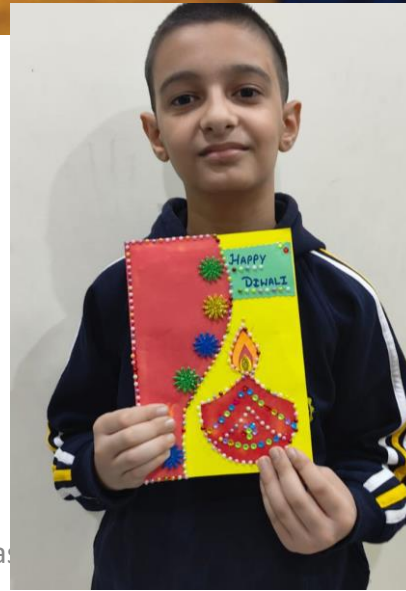
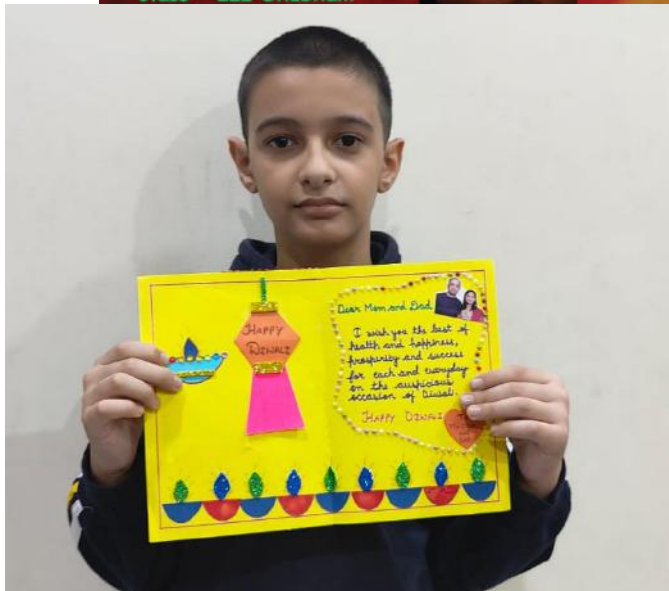
