





RECIPE: RASGULLA

Ingredients :Whole milk: 1 litreCurd: 1/2 cupice cold water: 1 litreSugar: 1 cupWater:

2 cupsCardamom powder: 1/4 tsp

In a pan bring the milk to boil .Once it starts boiling pour yoghurt on it.Let the milk curdle.Turn off the heat and leave it for 2 mins.Now add the chilled water to the curdled milk.Leave it aside for 2 to 3 minutes.Filter and collect the cheese in a cheese cloth or muslin cloth.Let the water drain completely.Then squeeze it nicely and drain off the water.Now knead the Cheese well to make into a smooth dough for about 10 minutes. Take small portions of it and roll to tiny balls. They should be tiny and not as big as it will double when boiling in sugar syrup.Add sugar and water to a wide pan and bring to a boil.To the boiling sugar syrup, add cardamom powder.Now add the balls one after the other gently. Cover the pan with a lid and cook for 10 mins on a medium high flame.Gently stir every 2-3 minutes to ensure even cooking and puffing. They will double in size when done.

BOOK - THE RUPA BOOK OF HAUNTED HOUSES


AUTHOR- RUSKIN BOND

Haunted houses are injurious to health. From his haunted rocking chair, Ruskin Bond takes you on a goose-pimply tour of some famous haunted houses in fiction.

With few exceptions, the occupants of the houses in these stories have come to an unpleasant sometimes messy end. Ghosts resent begin disturbed. They are fussy about who they must have as a neighbour. There is Thurnley abbey, with its terrifying midnight apparition; M R James's haunted doll's house: Hugh Walpole's sinister staircase; and the old manor houses whose hauntings are investigated by Flaxman Low, the Sherlock Holmes of the supernatural.

And there's Bram Stoker, who gives Dracula the night off and replaces him with an equally terrifying hanging judge. Read this when the night crawls by, about the unseen spooky inmates inhabiting houses that are haunted. It is a long tour of famous haunted houses in fiction from Walpole to Bram Stoker. 'The Rupa Book of Haunted Houses' (edited by Ruskin Bond) had Victorian (or Victorian-style) ghost stories. Read with your doors closed, lights dimmed; and be mindful of your house. In this anthology edited by Ruskin Bond, he shares some of his favourite ghost stories. Stories of ghosts who either resided or frequented and haunted certain houses.

Ruskin Bond is an Indian author of British descent. He is considered to be an icon among Indian writers and children's authors and a top novelist. He wrote his first novel, The Room on the Roof, when he was seventeen







SOME FACTS ABOUT INDIAN AIR FORCE

The Indian Air Force functions with the motto 'Nabham Sparsham Deeptham" which is "Touch the Sky with Glory".

- The Indian Air Force employs over 1,400 aircraft and around 170,000 personnel.
- The Indian Government, in January 2002, granted the rank of Marshal of the Air Force to Arjan Singh, thus making him the first and the only Five-star officer with the Indian Air Force and ceremonial chief of the air force.
- Indian Air Force is categorised into five operational and two functional commands.
- In 2010, the Air Force Network (AFNET), a robust digital information grid that enabled quick and meticulous threat responses, was launched.
- The Indian Air Force has been engaged in four wars with Pakistan and one with the People's Republic of China after its independence.
- The operations carried out by it are Operation Meghdoot, Operation Vijay – the invasion of Goa, Operation Cactus, and Operation Poomalai.
- It has also been involved in the United Nations peacekeeping missions.
- The Supreme Command of the Indian Armed Forces vests in the President. The responsibility for national defence rests with the Cabinet.







NATIONAL UNITY DAY


